

Visual Art – Pathways/Alignment: High School

Prerequisites for course requirements—Students may fulfill fine arts and elective requirements for graduation by successfully completing one or more of the following art courses, listed below with appropriate pathway followed. *Art I Visual Arts placement is a year-long consecutive course in the same content for mastery of appropriately leveled TEKS standards. According to the Texas Administrative Code, TAC §74.12(b)(7), each student must complete one credit in fine arts in high school. §74.3. (a)1-3 <http://ritter.tea.state.tx.us/rules/tac/chapter117/ch117c.html>.* Art II level courses require Art I prerequisite, Art III level courses require two years of prerequisites. All Art IV level courses require three years of prerequisites. Students entering Art courses for elective must complete appropriate prerequisites.

HS Year 1 of Art: *Students in High School begin with one of the following foundation courses in HS Year 1 and HS Year 2. (regardless of the student's grade).*

Texas Education Agency Endorsement Choices—Endorsements consist of a related series of courses that are grouped together by interest or skill set. They provide students with in-depth knowledge of a subject area. Students must select an endorsement in the ninth grade. If only one endorsement is offered, it must be multi-disciplinary studies. Students earn an endorsement by completing the curriculum requirements for the endorsement, including 4th credit of math and science and 2 additional elective credits. https://tea.texas.gov/communications/grad_toolkit/booklet.pdf

Fine Arts are included in 3 of the 5 state endorsements:

- **Business and Industry Endorsement:** A combination of areas including the Arts
- **Arts and Humanities Endorsement:** Courses from one or two areas (music, theater, art, dance) in fine arts
- **Multi-Disciplinary Studies Endorsement:** 4 credits in Advanced Placement, International Baccalaureate, or dual credit selected from English, mathematics, science, social studies, economics, LOTE or fine arts
