#### Appendix A. Applying to Houston I.S.D. PK Programs Page 3

**Important:** An "Offered" seat does not guarantee enrollment in an HISD Pre-K4 or Pre-K3 program. In order to be eligible for our HISD tuition-free Pre-K programs, your child will need to meet one of the seven criteria for Pre-K enrollment by the state of Texas or pay tuition if your child is found not eligible for an HISD free Pre-K program.

## **Pre-Kindergarten Eligibility**

**To be eligible for enrollment** in HISD non-tuition based prekindergarten program, a child must be 4 years of age on or before September 1<sup>st</sup> of the enrolling school year, a resident of HISD, and one of the following:

- be unable to speak and comprehend the English language, or
- be economically disadvantaged (defined below), or
- meet any eligibility criteria for Head Start, or
- be homeless, as defined by [42 USC 11434a], or
- currently be or has ever been in the conservatorship of the Department of Family and Protective Services following an adversary hearing held as provided by Section 262.201, Family Code, or
- be the child of an active duty member of armed forces or child of an armed forces member injured, killed, or missing in action while on active duty, or
- be the child of a person eligible for the Star of Texas Award as a peace officer as defined in Section 3106.002, a firefighter as defined in Section 3106.003, or an emergency medical first responder as defined in Section 3106.004

April 30, 2021 **Phase 1 Deadline:** Submit applications and to make changes to Phase 1 rankings. All *qualified and qualified pending* Phase 1 applications will be entered in lotteries. To make changes to Phase 1 rankings, either make changes online or complete a new application.

May 20, 2021 **Notification date:** On May 20, 2021, before midnight, the official Phase 1 notification of a students' lottery outcome will be viewable within the online application system's parent dashboard. An email notification of the Phase 1 lottery outcomes will be sent to the parent's email address.

In addition, one Pre-K application status letter is sent via U.S. Mail to the parents of all Phase 1 applicants that submitted a paper application. Phase 1 applicants that are offered a seat on May 20, 2021, will need to respond to the offer and make arrangements within two weeks of the notification date to provide documents to the school that has offered seat and schedule a language proficiency exam if qualifying to Pre-K due to language proficiency.

Additionally, please be aware that inclusion in a Pre-K program is contingent upon completion of the campus's enrollment process, within the timelines established by the campus. Moreover, the PreK enrollment transfer type requires principal approval and that this decision is made at the campus level. Students will remain on the waitlist of all programs which parents ranked higher than the highest program to which a seat is offered.

# Additional Information on Applications for the 2021-2022 School Year

- 1. Submit only one paper application and indicate up to 10 programs with a maximum of 5 magnet programs in **Section D**. Please do not submit separate applications for each choice.
- 2. You are required to rank your choices of programs to streamline the application process for all students.
- 3. If you wish to change the order of your rankings after you have submitted your initial application, you must submit an additional updated application to the Office of School Choice. **The deadline for changing Pre-K rankings is April 30, 2021.**
- 4. Any programs ranked below the highest program at which you are offered a seat are automatically dropped after the lottery is ran.
- 5. Students must be in attendance on day one of the school year. Pre-K seats are not saved if there are students to fill the spaces.
