Safety

- New check-out process
 - Limiting visitors to campus
 - Limiting visitors to school events
 - Some parents disapproved of limiting visitors to awards ceremony
 - Most parents understood why the limiting occurred
- Lockdowns
 - Some parents found the lockdown alarming
 - Drills are implemented throughout the year
 - We are standing on a sense of urgency and safety
 - We needed to capture the data on what points we needed to improve upon
 - You may want to review
 - Scan the hallway for any kids in the hallways
 - Major concern for parents that kids didn't know what to do
 - Kids should know to stay in the restroom if that's where they are during lockdown
 - Explain to students the 'why' of the lockdown

 - Nurse visited every classroom to pass out masks and wipes
 - It cannot be mandated, but we strongly encourage you to wear a mask, although it is still personal preference
