 - Enrollment –753
 - Next year’s projection – 761 - **Budget is very tight this year, especially for non-title one schools such as Bush.**
5. **Instruction**
 - TEKS based instruction on a 6-week schedule
6. School Improvement Plan (SIP) for the 2021 – 2022 school year
 - Review 2021 – 2022 SIP
 - Student performance/achievement on STAAR Reading will increase from 88% to 90% for “Approaches” and “Masters” will increase from 54% to 56%
 - Student performance/achievement on STAAR Math will increase from 88% to 90% for “Approaches” and “Masters” increase from 60% to 62%.
 - Student attendance will remain at 98%.
 - Continue to provide a safe and orderly learning environment.
 - Continue to be in compliance with HISD guidelines for identification and serving of our students in various special populations
So far, we are on track with goals including our 4545 intervention and Nurse has completed screening for vision and hearing.
 - Third Review Due March 25 **–our last one was completed in January**

8. Other School Events/Concerns
 - Modified Field Day – March 11, 2022 – **Coach Pham and her specialist team have been hard at work planning fun and exciting activities for the students. There is also a back up plan to hold field day inside in case of rain. Students and staff are encouraged to wear athletic clothing on this day.**

- Recess time will be altered if scheduled during the picnic
- Playground equipment is off limits during the picnic

- Only 2 parents/non-school aged sibling per child will be allowed to attend, color coded wristbands will be sent home with each child, can't bring others, no entry without the wristbands.
- Grade level “release” sticker if parents decide to take their child home - **Students must sign out with their teacher before they leave early with their parents. Once they sign out, they will be given a grade level sticker to wear as they exit the gate with their parents to make sure they have signed out with the teacher.**
- **Siblings in strollers/babies or toddlers count as one admission and must have a wrist band to enter.**
If families want to eat together – the older sibling will go to eat with the family and the younger/youngest sibling. Parents will need to email the older sibling's teacher to let them know that they have permission to leave their area and go to eat with the family and the younger sibling's class.
- 2022 – 2023 Registration Dates will be announced in April in the Paw Prints and on the website. Registration will be in-person.
This will be the order for registration this year:
1st – intent to re-enroll for current Bush students
2nd - entering kindergarten with a sibling already here at Bush
3rd – entering kindergarten without a sibling enrolled at Bush
4th - 1st – 5th graders – this registration will not be held until after school is out to allow parents to obtain a copy of the end of year report card showing successful completion of the 2021-2022 school year.
- PK & K Parent Orientations – late May/June In-person
These will be in-person orientations and will include a tour of the school.
