Budget:

Enrollment: 760 (over enrollment projected)- able to get money back in our budget b/c we were over projection

Enrollment Goals:

- Average: 780 students
- Make sure we are filling up additional spots in classrooms that have low enrollment

Money from Budget gets us:

- Funds sub
- Teacher assistants in classrooms (SPED)
- Purchase additional instructional materials; IB Resources set aside \$5,000 for that

Attendance: We are below average due to pandemic. District-wide attendance is down. We are at 93% (we are usually at 96%)

ESSER funds(Elementary Secondary School Emergency Relief Funds) : money to get students caught up due to learning loss from pandemic; Federal Funds to pay for things

*We received \$46,000

After school tutorials: We can have teachers who have been tutoring their own students, Saturday tutorials

\$50/hr. for after school tutorials

Interventionists-- Funded another interventionist (Ms. Thomason) HB45

Health & Safety Fund: constrictive on what we can buy; masks, PPE, nurse extra duty hours, morning duties

Campus Innovation Fund: we've received 13,000; \$10,000 subs for professional development, \$3,000 used for other resources

Wraparound Fund: uniform, clothes, other items for students in need

Instruction:

I.B. updates:

- We are in the middle of self-study
- Evaluation next year- We want to make sure the community is involved in the process as well.
- Professional development focus on Feb. 1st
- Grade levels will be provided additional IB planning in the Spring to discuss what else is needed

SIP (School Improvement Plan for 2021-22 School Year)

- STAAR Math/Reading:
 - Current Pandemic levels: 71% approaches level 39% meets level 22% Mastery level
 - Goal by end of year: We'd like to get to Pre-pandemic levels: 84% approaches 56% meets 44% mastery
 - Student Attendance goal: 96% (pre-pandemic); 93% is where we are

Other Thoughts:

4th Grade Question that was brought up : Professional Development → IB training for teachers that plan to come back, where is the money coming from? Not willing to do virtual- Response: Money coming from PTO professional development money (\$5,000 already given, \$5,000 coming once more funding) and school funding.

- Next year potential PD in summer and Fall – Category 1 training; Choice sessions

- Training for Category 2 and 3 – McClish and Linen will discuss potential training for Category 2 and 3/ veteran teachers

Fall Fundraiser: Families donate blankets was very successful
