#### **HCC FERPA FORMS**

HCC FERPA Forms allow professors and parents to communicate once and only if students turn them in.

The first form is the notary form. This form is used when students are unable to be in person at the HCC Campus Registration Office. Once complete, students submit the form to HCC. Students/parents should submit the completed Notary form to their Grade Level Dean.

The second form, the FERPA Release Form, is the traditional form used in non-Covid times. Students complete this form in person at the HCC Campus Registration Office.



- P Vaccination Cards: Please forward a copy of your vaccine card to <u>Nurse Shioura</u> via email and add the student(s)' name in the subject line.
- P Parents/Guardians: All parents should log into the Parent Portal and ensure that contact information including emails are correct.







They are still having fun, exploring new challenges, some they like and some not so much, and winning awards.


