FREE COVID-19 SCREENING TESTING FOR STUDENTS AND CAMPUS STAFF

In order to participate in the district COVID testing programming on campus, parent/guardian must first give consent.

To give consent to participate in the COVID-19 testing program, please follow these steps:

- 1. Go to <u>https://bit.ly/HISDC19Test</u> and click on the "begin" button to start the consent process.
- 2. Enter your child's student ID and select their school (if you are providing consent for more than one child, you will need to complete the form for each child).
- 3. On the following screen, please enter your child's date of birth, first name, and last name.
- 4. You will be asked to enter an email address to continue. After entering your preferred email address, you will be sent a link to confirm registration and finalize your child's information. Please note that the link is time-sensitive and expires in 36 hours. For complete step-by-step instructions, please click <u>here.</u>
