



Shared Decision-Making Committee (SDMC)
Meeting Minutes
May 4, 2022

The meeting was called to order at 3:15 p.m.

Welcome –

Mr. Church welcomed the members to the SDMC meeting. The agenda for the meeting was read, and a motion to approve the minutes was made. Minutes were approved.

Budget

Mr. Church explained that Travis will continue next year with a budget like this year's budget. Over 97% of the budget will be used for teacher and staff salaries as in previous years. Travis was able to increase its student projection for next year to 716 students, which reflects an increased number of students who have already registered for next year. This projection will allow Travis to add an additional teacher. The committee discussed where this teacher might be placed, and it was agreed that the additional teacher be added to the K-2 grade level with the highest number of students. Mr. Church will provide a budget update at the next SDMC meeting in the fall.

Student Class Placement for Next Year

The committee discussed a timeline for making next year's class placements available to families at the end of this school year instead of waiting until August. If all goes according to plan, class placements will be provided to students on their final report card.

Playground/Spark Park Improvements

The committee discussed options for replacing or adding structures on the playground/Spark Park. Among the items discussed were the red and blue playscape, the climbing wall, the green equipment, sand boxes, and the basketball court. It was decided that the 120 chart and lines for basketball would be painted again on the basketball court. The separate playground committee will continue to discuss other items, and a follow-up report will be made to the SDMC in the fall.

SDMC Election

An election for new SDMC committee members will be held the first week of June.

New Items

Behavior management in the KV after school program was discussed, including the impact it has on the school custodial staff.

Next Meeting

The next SDMC meeting will be held in the fall.
