SIP Formative Review covered with Prelim STAAR/TELPAS data and other areas of our campus goals also updates to campus adjustments to make increased gains next year. SIP Committee will be trained and begin working this summer.

Final budget left us in a deficit so spending will be limited to needs over wants. ESSER funds are plenty to cover tutorials and summer tutorials during summer school. Enrollment projection for 2022-2023 is 942 students. We are healthy with budget for next year as long as we meet projection. Summer recruitment efforts to begin in June/July.

Master Schedule will include 6 periods (averaging 52-55 minutes) daily. All contents every day in all grade levels. Homeroom with modified schedule days planned for testing and other needs. Advocacy period for interventions/enrichment/SEL/STEM projects around lunch times. Students will rotate to teachers based on student needs/data trends. One trained Dyslexia staff member per grade level in ELA to service those students in advocacy. Hourly tutors push-in/pull-out for Tier 2 & 3. HB4545 in Summer School. Staffing interviews continuing weekly beginning May 2022. Thank you to Sims and Marks for referring people to Fondren.
