- Updates
 - COVID
 - We should be getting new rapid tests for our campus.
 - Staffing
 - We will be getting a new nurse. She will be starting the week we come back from the Thanksgiving Break.
 - Budget
 - Due to COVID-19 the enrollment and attendance has been low throughout the district. Our enrollment and attendance have not been the same as previous years
 - We were at 677 enrolled students on October Snap Shots last year. Last year we predicted our projected enrollment for this coming year, which we projected 750. As of right now we have 640 students enrolled. The number of students determines how much funding we get for the rest of the year.
 - Our campus was not a HUB school at the beginning of the year, but we are now a HUB for the surrounding schools, this will increase our enrollment a little bit.
 - We are saving our funds in case we owe money to the district if we do not meet our enrollment.
 - Calendar
 - We are finishing Snapshot and High Frequency Words testing and we have starting GT testing and will finish once we get back from the break.
 - We do not expect an increase of the in-person kids, but we will be looking at class sizes to balance out if we do have an increase.
