Students

Teachers

- Will prepare and deliver effective instruction daily to ensure students are receiving a quality education.
- Will come to work on time daily.
- Will share with parents and students a reading log and tips/resources based on student reading level.
- Will host two family nights to preview math and reading lessons and share strategies with parents
- Will send student homework and conduct on a daily basis.
- Will provide small-group or 1-1 instruction on a regular basis to support struggling students

Parents

- Will check your child/children's homework and conduct every day.
- Will provide opportunities for your child/children to read at least 30 minutes a day at home.

- Will make sure your child/children come to school in dress code.
- Will make arrangements to have your child dropped off/and pick up on time.
- Will collaborate and participate with the school in all events.
- Will keep the school/teacher informed when there is a concern that may impact the child's academic performance.

Davila Goals and Focus Areas

Davila's goal for 2021 – 2022 school year is to earn the six maximum allowable distinctions on the TEA Accountability Report. We will focus on four goals for this school year:

- **Reading Goal:** The combined scores of STAAR reading did not meet last year's goal of 80% in grades 3rd-5th. By the end of the 2021 - 2022 school year, the percent of students who scored at approaches on STAAR Reading will increase from 73% to 80%, the percent of students who scored at meets will increase from 44% to 56%, and masters will increase from 22% to 25%.
- **Math Goal:** The combined scores of STAAR math did not meet last year's goal of 85% in grades 3rd-5th. By the end of the 2021 – 2022 school year, the percent of students who scored at approaches on STAAR Math will increase from 65% to 85%, the percent of students who scored at meets will increase from 28% to 53%, and masters will increase from 13% to 34%.

- **Science Goal:** By the end of the 2021 - 2022 school year, the percent of students who scored at approaches on STAAR Science will increase from 57% - 75%, the percent of students who scored at meets will increase from 25% to 48%, and masters will increase from 5% to 21%.
