

SDMC Meeting Minutes

May 31, 2022

The meeting began at 3:08pm J. Adams asked how we can increase parental involvement on campus. Nurse Mosley stated the school had a PTO in the past and they sold popcorn and conducted other fund raisers. Ms. Luviano suggested we have Muffins with mom and Donuts for Dad campus wide. Ms. Dunn suggested we have a Fall carnival as a fund raiser and each grade level would be responsible for a booth. Family Literacy, Math, and Science Night were other suggestions given to help increase parents support with academics. During the literacy night parents would read to students and engage in different activities with students. Ms. Luviano also suggested having parent conferences at the end of the 1st 6 weeks to let parents know where the students are and what they can do to help their child continue to progress. Nurse Mosley asked the classroom teachers, what are some challenges you have when trying to get in contact with parents? Ms. Dunn said, text messages gets the best response. Google numbers can be used but if its necessary to your phone may be confiscated. Providing in coming parents with directions on how to sign get access to Class Dojo was another suggestion to ensure we stay connected to parents.

J. Adams provided the attendance data, our campus current attendance percentage is 85% which is extremely low for an elementary campus. The district standards are 98% attendance for elementary campuses. She asked what can we do to increase the campus attendance rate. Ms. Dunn suggested celebrating classes with pizza, ice cream, and dance parties if their class has perfect attendance for a grading cycle. J. Adams suggested having a raffle or prize drawing for parents of student who have perfect attendance. She stated, the parents are responsible for getting the students to school each day. Ms. Villarreal suggested creating a bulletin board that shows classes with 100% attendance or the class average. Announcements providing students and staff with percent of attendance daily was another suggestion.

Ms. Luviano says she has a system where she displays ATTENDANCE and each day the class has perfect attendance, they turn a letter over and once ATTENDACED is spelled out they have a party or celebration. Bingo nights every 6 weeks or end of first and second semester for parents of students with perfect attendance.

Ms. Semien provided information on the current preliminary results from STAAR online

Math- 3rd Bilingual out of 42 students 12% masters, 18% met, 17% approach 52% DNM

Math – 3rd ENG 8% mastered, 12% met, 22% approaches, 58%DNM

Math - 4th Bilingual 100% DNM

Math - 5th 100% DNM

Ms. Semien provided information on Imagine Literacy usage – We only have 3 classes with students who have completed -lessons. J. Adams asked What do we need to do as a campus to improve students' usage and lessons completed? Reminding teachers and students every morning and proving students

with incentives as they passed lessons each week. Providing a computer schedule in the computer lab with classroom teachers. J. Adams suggested making the data visible and creating competition against grade levels. Ms. Walker suggested making technology apart of each teachers small group rotation to ensure students have time on the programs. In the morning during breakfast provide students with computer time was another suggestion. One person stated we should provide each class with 5 computers. Ms. Luviano said her students prefer to use Freckles and Ms. Dunn stated she can add Imagine Learning to the Sp. Ed schedule.
