Agenda/Minutes

- State of the School- We are currently at 91.3% attendance rate, 0 staff is out because of COVID, 100 % staffed
- Data- Review of DLA scores for 3rd, 4th, and 5th. The focus and goal is on STAAR growth and success. Domain 2 is our target domain with growth in 4th and 5th grade scholars.
- Committee Meeting Introduction- Mr. Kimble introduced himself, the SDCM members, and the purpose.
- Target Improvement Plan- Mr. Kimble shared the updated focus for the school improvement plan. The focus will be on strong planning and effective instruction for teachers. He plans to enhance strong planning by continuing to coach teachers, increase leadership planning, create authentic planning aligned with the scholars needs, and hire additional consultants. The plans to increase effective instruction by visiting and documenting teachers, giving effective feedback and coaching, and then revisiting teachers.
- School Funding- Supplies and currently being purchased. Mr. Kimble plans to maximize all remaining funds on consulting for summer scholars. Current spending is being done for Reading and Science consultants. Esser funds are being used to offer students tutoring after school and on Saturdays, buy assessment prep licensure, and mentorship programs for 40 students. Over 50% of students are close to meeting or finishing the required 30 hours needed to meet House bill 4545. As a result, tutorials will be added for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd grade scholars to fill in academic gaps. Also, Esser funds will be used to hire consultant to revamp and regrow administration and teachers on effective ways a improve achievement gaps.
- School Improvement Grant – Mr. Kimble has applied for need technology for both teachers and scholars. Many of the teachers have had their same computer 3 or plus years. The grant will assist in getting teachers updated computers. The grant will also purchase 40 iPad for scholars. The goal is to get students to 1 to 1 with technology.
- Programs – Mr. Kimble highlighted the great job done on the Core Enrichment Showcase. Current Partnership programs have also been a huge success and support for scholars. Scholars have received lunches, parties, gifts, virtual field trips, and gardens
- Upcoming Programs- Black History, Basketball games, Saturday tutorials, The Chosen Mentorship Program (mentor 40 students starts in February), Spring Show
- Upcoming Assessment- Benchmarks, High Frequency Words, Snap , Telpas (small amount of students), Renaissance MOY, MOCK STAAR
