Called to Order at 3:30 pm. Meeting was rescheduled from October 26, 2021.

Celebrations

We discussed the staff spotlights. Victoria Velez was Staff Member of the Month and Ana Gonzales had Perfect Attendance for the month of September. Edgar Montoya was Staff Member of the Month and Cynthia Rosignon had Perfect Attendance for the Month of October. We celebrated our bus drivers the month of October. We held our first teacher At-Bats to help improve our Tier I instruction. Our student highlights include the Character Book Parade, the soccer team, and our Perfect Award Winners for September and October.

Budget

We still need to staff 3 bilingual teacher positions. We currently have hourly personnel in those positions that are working on their teacher certifications. Those positions are reducing our General Funds budget. We are also looking for a new academic tutor to be paid out of Title 1.

Our current enrollment is 553 and we exceeded our projection of 520. The addition of those 33 students should bring approximately \$105,600 to the budget in the spring.

The district has funded a Counselor and Interventionist from ESSER Funds. Also paid from ESSER funds are tutorials for HB4545. Certified teachers get \$50 for tutorials. All other personnel will receive their regular extra duty pay.

We have secured tutors from Trice and iEducate to push into classroom and to pull small group interventions during the school day. We have spent \$64,000 for those 4 tutors.

Instruction and Testing

Our Snapshot 1 should be completed this week. The data PLC will be facilitated by our Data-Driven Instructional Specialist.

High Frequency Word Evaluation window has opened until November 19, 2021. This is a part of promotion standards for 1st and 2nd grade. Students will have 3 opportunities to test. If they pass the first time they do not test again.

Renaissance Progress Monitoring

Parents will receive letters on their child's performance for the Reading and Math Renaissance test after the progress monitoring window.

Camp Spark

The 2 additional instructional days will take place during the winter break, 12/20 & 12/21. The dates are mandatory for all campuses. We will need to start asking teachers if they want to participate.

Family and Community Engagement

We will host our Fall Festival Saturday, November 13, 2021 from 10:00am-12:00pm outside on the blacktop area. We will pre-sale tickets November 1-12. COVID guidelines and restrictions will still be in place. Donations are being accepted until November 12. Ms. Vermeire will reach out to her artist friend to see if she can face paint. Pastor Denkins asked if we could have the immunization truck come out as well.
