

SDMC Minutes
Public Meeting via Teams
May 25, 2023

Meeting called to order: 3:10pm

Attendees: T. Garrett, J. Hill, K. Hunt, N. Washington, D. Andrews, C. Flores, S. Brown

Old Business:

- Attendance 93.9% year to date
 - \$107,290 lost
 - 20 5% students with perfect attendance
 - Suggestions include incentives every 6 weeks, pizza party or other incentive
 - Monthly reward certificates from restaurants or other vendors

- Safety & Security
 - S. Brown raised safety concern about the safety of the playground equipment. It is worn and aged. T. Garrett will request assistance from the District with replacement. T. Garrett advised that request for repair or replacement have been made prior to this year due to the slide scratching students. The playground was closed in March as a precaution. The equipment was inspected, but there was no guidance on next steps. T. Garrett will request replacement of the playground equipment and basketball goals.

 - The committee discussed options for improving traffic flow. K. Hunt suggested moving buses further down LaBranch and recommending that 3-5 cars travel up LaBranch, Pk-K cars travel up Rosedale to improve flow on both streets.

 - T. Garrett shared that a community member expressed concern with cars parking in their driveway or in the esplanade on Crawford. The campus will provide reminders to parents.

 - The garden bed walls were repaired by the grounds department. The bricks were reset and adhesive was applied to stabilize them.

- SpEd Updates-Ms. Andrews reported the following:
 - MacGregor will have a new self-contained SLC TREK class for 23-24.
 - The campus is in compliance with all deadlines and district requirement.

New Business:

- T Garrett reported that a PD survey will be sent to teachers to capture PD needs for 23-24. Training will include Amplify, Eureka, and iReady.
