1. Welcome

- Made a lot of progress last year - made an A in growth
- We did not do well with student achievement
- Pg. 8: Board has a goal - third grade reading goal will increase from 58% to 70% in the Meets area
- Measures/Plans: Running Records, Renn 360, Data-driven instructional talks

 - We met our growth goals last year, but work still remains to become an A-rated campus.

- 3. Budget remaining at a Glance**
- o GF1 (general funds ... approx \$2mil)
 - o Activities funds (money fundraised)
 - allocated towards the budgets
 - had to give money back due to attendance
 - 45K
 - four main “buckets of money)
 - o Title I 197K
 - Can be used to buy computers/chromebooks
 - open positions, buy materials for students, and buy computers
 - o Esser II 144K
 - must be used or we lose it
 - o Esser III 32K
 - must be used or we lose it
- 4. Positions open**
- o Nurse
 - three possible offers but two decided not to take it
 - o Possible two teaching positions using Title I money
 - reduced classroom sizes
 - Title 1 positions specifically 5th grade... V. Aleman
 - first grade position... Ms. Dominguez
 - Possible to get a second grade teacher to accommodate the many first graders
 - o One TA for Sped.
 - Zavala will become Ms. Vanhorn’s assistance
 - If another academic tutor is needed, it will come out of the ESSER fund

5. Enrollment update 548

- This years goal was 560 and had to give back \$45k
- Giving smaller number next year in hopes to keep money
- Closed Lugo's and Dominguez's position in hopes to reopen with Title One money

6. Needs or Concerns

1. Can we use ESSER funds to buy chromebooks so we can become 1-to-1 for wholegroup online lessons?
2. Safety: There has been inspections done by district (40 days ago) and an "intruder" came into the building and started walking around and a couple of employees saw her and noticed she didnt have a badge. It did not happen and because she was a familiar face. The first time we didnt pass was because a few doors were unlocked. She came back this week and to see if doors were unlocked but the gym wasnt locked so we failed. Many doors do not have an automatic door that closes the door behind people so Mr. Sabillon will check into that... May check into using the ESSER III funds for that. Today they sent someone from the district and WE PASSED!!!! YAY!!! 😊
 - Teachers have to line up in the parent line and come into the gate in the morning.. the plan is to make it so teachers use the exit as an entrance so there wont be an issue with entrances
3. Mr. Galvan inquired about creating a door for students to access the garden from inside the school (from the glass) instead of having to go all the way around the front to go to it.
4. Mr. Galvan: Need more teachers interacting with parents
5. Ms. Wimberley's idea for Academic Night once a month... next step getting more teachers involved
