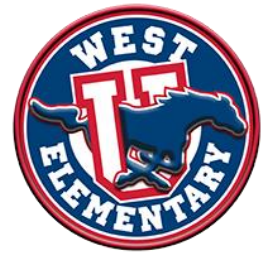

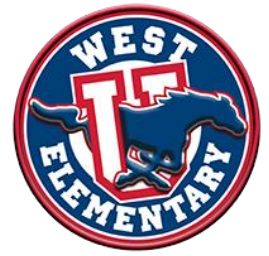
- I. Call to order
