3. SDMC Meeting Schedule

4. **Budget - State of the School**
 - Enrollment –738
 - Last year’s projection – 761 Ended up being 29 children off – money removed from budget- ESL/GT dependent for additional funding
 - This year’s projection – Due February over next week – funding model not known yet- seeing trends and patterns for next year’s projection
5. **Instruction**
 - TEKS based instruction on a 6-week schedule
6. School Improvement Plan (SIP) for the 2022 – 2023 school year
 - Review 2022 – 2023 SIP nothing has changed
 - Student performance/achievement on STAAR Reading will increase from 88% to 90% for “Approaches” and “Masters” will increase from 54% to 56%
 - Student performance/achievement on STAAR Math will increase from 88% to 90% for “Approaches” and “Masters” increase from 60% to 62%.
 - Student attendance will remain at 98%.
 - Continue to provide a safe and orderly learning environment.
 - Continue to be in compliance with HISD guidelines for identification and serving of our students in various special populations
