- Love by the Numbers: Demographic Breakdown
  - 50/50 DL Pre-K-5, English strand PK-2
  - 350 Ss enrolled (324 projection)
  - 36% EBs
  - 74% Eco. Disadv.
  - 55% At risk
  - 9% SPED, 2% 504, 3% Dyslexia
  - 6% GT
  - Demographics May 2023 (50% Male, 50% Female)
    - 76% Hispanic
    - 4% Black
    - 15% White
    - 2% Asian
    - 3% two or more
- STAAR Data Review
  - Historically the campus has been a C/D rating
  - “A” distinction from last year came from growing Ss, credit by systems put in from Bass, predecessor
  - Review of data chart from 2019-2023 was presented and reviewed
- TEA Accountability
  - 2021-2022 - A Rating - Score 96 (C in Domain 1 and A in Domains 2 and 3)
  - 2020-2021 - Not Rated
  - 2019-2020 - Not Rated
  - 2018-2019 - C Rating - Score 74
  - 2017-2018 - Met Standard - Score 78
- School Action Plan - Discussion and Voting Item
  - The action plan was reviewed, the 4 key action areas.
  - Questions that arose:
    - MRS ability to reach the goal stated on plan? Yes many Ts were already doing them/just rebranded.
    - Tellez explained how Ss growth will be taken from Dibels/Lectura and NWEA Testing. Munoz reiterated that DL will need to do both English and Spanish. This will be connected to principal autonomy and pay, this presentation is forthcoming.
    - Tellez went over how the campus will foster community and family engagement.
