Minutes

Introduction to the School Improvement Plan (SIP):

Review of Key Actions:

Key Action 3:

"Increase the level of student engagement through the use of high-quality instructional materials (HQIM) with the use of multiple response strategies (MRS), initiating a positive and

engaging learning environment that enhances the campus culture of learning and fosters a strong sense of community."

Members deliberated on incorporating high-quality instructional materials, utilizing diverse engagement strategies to create an inclusive and dynamic learning environment, implementing multiple response strategies, and fostering a positive and engaging learning environment to enhance the overall school culture.

Staff Contributions:

The committee discussed the significant purpose of a schoolwide contribution to ensure the success of the SIP. Ideas included collaborative lesson planning, professional learning communities, and creating a supportive network for sharing best practices.

Approval of the School Improvement Plan:

After thorough discussion and consideration of suggestions, Principal Galindo called for a motion to approve the School Improvement Plan for the 2023-2024 school year.

The motion was seconded, and the plan was approved unanimously.
