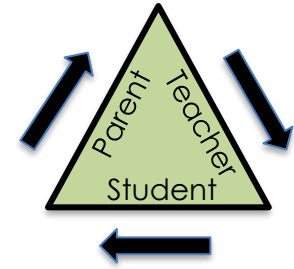

Parent(s)/ Guardian Agreement

- I agree to volunteer when available as a Fonwood Parent Actively Working (PAW) in one or more ways. (Dedicated parent, field trip monitor, etc.)
- I agree to use the right car seat correctly every time I drop off and pick up my child from school so I can keep my child safe.
- I agree to refrain from being on any device while dropping or picking up my child to and from school so I can keep my child and others safe.

Student Agreement:

- I will use kind words. Teachers will model using kind words in the classroom with students i.e. please and thank you.
- I will use helping hands. Students can use their helping hands at school by helping other students open their food during breakfast or lunch, helping friends tie their shoes and sharing with others.)
- I will use my big voice. Students are taught by the classroom teacher how to verbally express wants and needs to others in an assertive voice.
- I will listen to other's big voice. Students are taught at school how to attentively listen and follow instructions when others use their big voice.
- I agree to follow classroom agreements. Teachers will create classroom agreements with the assistance of students. Agreements are used in place of classroom rules.

Teacher Agreement:
