1. **Welcome- Mr. Sabillon welcomes parents a reviews the agenda.**
  - a. **100% staffed- Mr. Sabillon shares good news. The school is at 100% fully staffed for the 2024-2025 school year. The school will continue to be NES. Principal Sabillon translates in Spanish.**

A parent called that she did receive a letter from State Rep Armando Walle. The letter indicates that the parent received the letter as if she complained and she did not. Parent’s names and teachers’ names are listed as they filed a complaint without authorization.**

Parents asked what the next steps are. Principal Sabillon mentions to parents that this has been communicated to the Executive Director. Principal Sabillon reads the allegations.

Parent Y.C. asks how did the person get the parent’s information and asks if it’s a teacher who has left. Parent thinks it could be a teacher.

Mr. Galvan-We need to provide our kids with more books. Some of our children only have what we have at school. This information needs to be expressed to parents. We only met with parents and teachers at the beginning. I know some parents are always here.

Ms. Jacquet-The issue is not the parents who come, it is the parent's who don't come. The issue is that we always get the parents whose kids are excelling.
