Our 9th, 10th, and 11th graders will take the PSAT (8/9 or NMSQT) on Thursday, October 12, 2023. All 9th, 10th, and 11th grade students have been registered to take this test free of charge. All students who are testing must arrive on campus by 8:30 AM with their fully charged laptop, computer charger and school ID. Students arriving late will not be allowed to test. 




