Cold Weather Gear Reminder!

As it gets colder I want to remind our Lamar families of the acceptable ways to dress to stay warm and still be in dress code. Students may wear any color long sleeve shirt under their Lamar IB Logo collared shirt. Students who wish to wear sweatshirts or jackets should have the Lamar logo jackets and sweatshirts on over the collared shirt. The collared shirt is required Monday-Thursday, with the option for spirit t-shirts on Fridays.

Non-Lamar outerwear should be removed while on campus. Heavy coats may be worn outside on campus when the temperature dips below 50 degrees.

Juniors and Seniors in SL and HL Courses

<u>Please complete this form</u> by November 1st at 4 pm to request accommodations on your IB exams that will take place in the spring semester. These are official IB exams, not class exams or final exams. You may only request accommodations that you currently have through your 504 or IEP. Sometimes the IB requests additional documentation to determine accommodations. If requested, you will need to email the documents to Dr. Acord by Nov. 1st at 4 pm. Contact Dr. Acord if you have questions. <u>suzanne.acord@houstonisd.org</u>. Form must be completed by the student.

IB Fee for 11th and 12th Grade Families

All 11th and 12th graders taking one or more IB classes are required to pay an annual \$90 IB fee. 11th and 12th grade IB course names end in SL and HL. If you see SL or HL on your child's schedule, your child is in an IB course. This fee supports IB materials, digital resources, and teacher trainings for our IB programs. The actual fee that HISD pays to the IB is \$119 per course. When a student tests in five IB courses, HISD pays the IB \$595. The annual fee of \$90 is due by **October 13th, 2023**.


