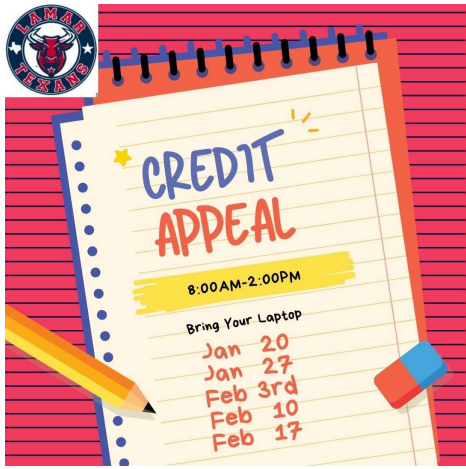

### FAQs

**Where do we enter?** Garage entrance, 2nd Floor Athletic Lobby

**Can we park in the garage?** Yes! Even if you do not have a parking permit, please park in the garage.
