In 2014, Houston ISD launched the Global Graduate Initiative with the goal of ensuring that each HISD student graduates ready for the world. To this end, HISD has made strides to increase participation in college readiness and entrance assessments since 2009, preparing students to be college and career ready upon graduation.

This College-Bound Report provides a brief synopsis of HISD students' participation in and performance on the 2017–2018 administrations of the PSAT 8/9, PSAT/NMSQT, SAT, ACT, Advanced Placement (AP) exams, and International Baccalaureate (IB) exams. Data for HISD students enrolled in advanced/dual credit courses and in college upon high school graduation are also presented. For additional information and expanded data disaggregated by demographics, assessment-specific reports can be found on HISD's Research and Accountability website at <http://www.houstonisd.org/Domain/8269>.

Key findings include:

- More HISD high school students are taking college readiness and entrance assessments than in previous years. Although rates of participation have remained relatively flat because of the increase in district enrollment, a greater number of students are taking these tests.
- On the PSAT 8/9 and PSAT/NMSQT, average scores decreased slightly from 2016 to 2017. Performance may have been negatively impacted due to Hurricane Harvey since the test was administered four weeks after the majority of students returned to school. While HISD students tend to score slightly higher on average in math, a larger proportion met the Evidence-Based Reading and Writing (ERW) College and Career Readiness (CCR) benchmark.
- While the number of students taking the SAT has increased, the percentage tested has remained consistent. Performance of HISD students increased from 2017 to 2018 but was lower than that of the state and nation.
- On the ACT exam, scale scores increased slightly across all subject areas from 2015 to 2018, and the percentage of students meeting all benchmarks increased to 34 percent in 2018.
- From 2017 to 2018, the number of AP exams taken and the student participation rate decreased slightly, but the number and percentage of exams scored 3 or higher increased.
- In 2018, the number of students taking IB exams increased, and the percentage of exams scored at 4 or higher increased.
- Approximately 40 percent of HISD students in grades 9–12 have completed at least one advanced/dual credit course, indicating that many HISD high school students are being prepared for college-level work. A larger number of HISD students are also enrolling in higher education; however, the percentage of these students is not increasing.

As this is a summary of previously provided data, the district's administrative response to the results of each assessment was provided in the separate reports produced earlier in the year. # College-Bound Assessment Report 2017–2018

## Executive Summary

### Program Description

In 2014, Houston Independent School District (HISD) launched the Global Graduate Initiative with the goal that each HISD student graduates ready for the world. The profile of an HISD Global Graduate is one of a leader, a skilled communicator, adaptable and productive, a critical thinker, a responsible decision maker, and a college-ready learner. HISD has increased participation in college readiness and entrance assessments since 2009 with the implementation and expansion of programs such as SAT School Day and funding both the cost of PSAT exams to sophomores and Advanced Placement (AP) Exams to all students.

This report provides a brief analysis of HISD students' participation in and performance on the 2017–2018 administrations of the Preliminary SAT for students in grades 8 and 9 (PSAT 8/9), the Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test (PSAT/NMSQT), the SAT, ACT, AP, and International Baccalaureate (IB) exams. Data for HISD students enrolled in advanced/dual credit courses and in college upon high school graduation are also presented.

### Highlights

- Although rates of participation have remained consistent, a greater number of students are taking college readiness and entrance exams.
- On the PSAT 8/9 and PSAT/NMSQT, average scores decreased slightly from 2016 to 2017. Performance may have been negatively impacted due to Hurricane Harvey since the test was administered four weeks after most students returned to school. While HISD students scored higher on average in math, a larger proportion met the Evidence-Based Reading and Writing (ERW) College and Career Readiness (CCR) benchmark.
- While the number of students taking the SAT has increased, the percentage tested has remained consistent. Performance of HISD students increased from 2017 to 2018 but was lower than that of the state and total group.
- On the ACT exam, scale scores increased across all subject areas from 2015 to 2018, and the percentage meeting all benchmarks increased to 34 percent in 2018, exceeding state and national performance.
- From 2017 to 2018, the number of AP exams taken and the student participation rate decreased slightly, but the number and percentage of exams scored 3 or higher increased.
- In 2018, the number of students taking IB exams increased, and the percentage of exams scored at 4 or higher increased.
- Approximately 40 percent of HISD students enrolled in grades 9–12 have completed an advanced/dual credit course, indicating that many HISD high school students are being prepared for college-level work. A larger number of HISD students are also enrolling in higher education; however, the percentage of these students is not increasing.

## Introduction

This report provides a brief analysis of Houston Independent School District (HISD) participation in and performance on the 2017–2018 administrations of the PSAT 8/9 assessment, the Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test (PSAT/NMSQT), the SAT, ACT, Advanced Placement (AP), and International Baccalaureate (IB) exams. Data for HISD students enrolled in advanced/dual credit courses and in college upon high school graduation are also presented.

## Results

### PSAT

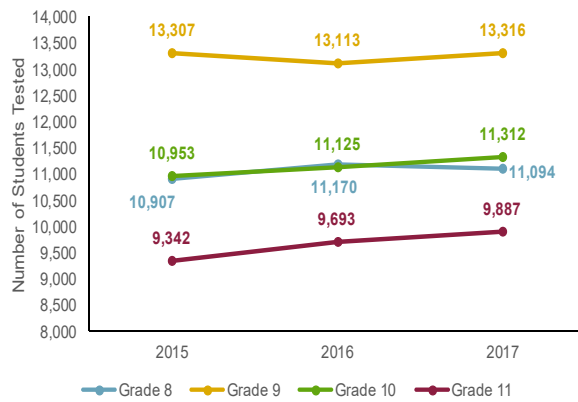
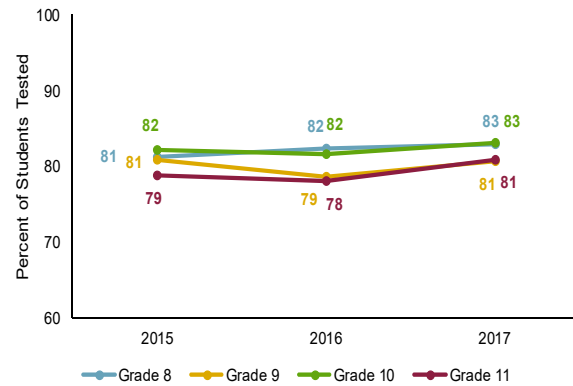
The PSAT 8/9 replaced the ReadStep assessment from the College Board in the 2015–2016 academic year as a low-stakes middle school assessment and serves as the first step on the “College Readiness Pathway” preparing 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> grade students for the PSAT/NMSQT and for the SAT. PSAT 8/9 has two sections: Evidence-Based Reading and Writing (ERW) and Mathematics.

The Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test (PSAT/NMSQT) is a national examination administered in October of each year by the College Board and consists of two sections: Evidence-Based Reading and Writing (ERW) and Mathematics. The 2015 version was redesigned to coincide with the redesign of the SAT and addition of PSAT 8/9. Prior versions of the PSAT/NMSQT had three sections, testing Critical Reading, Writing, and Mathematics.

The PSAT/NMSQT serves as preparation for the SAT and is a qualifying examination for numerous scholarship programs sponsored by corporations, colleges and universities, and other organizations, including the National Merit scholarships. Students can qualify for these scholarships depending on the score they earn on the exam in their junior year. HISD provides funding so that all freshmen and sophomores are able to take the PSAT/NMSQT test for free. Additionally, HISD offers the College Board Early Preparation Program to incoming freshmen in order to prepare them for the SAT and SAT Subject Tests.

### How many students participated in the PSAT?

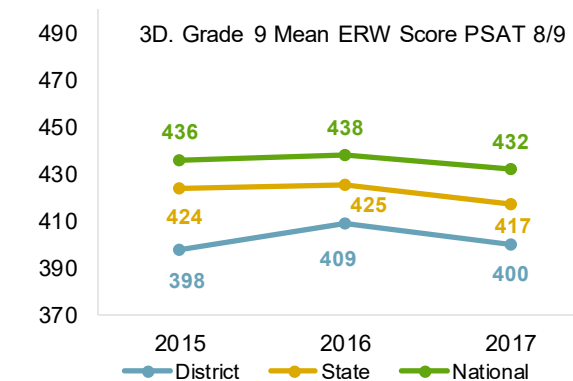
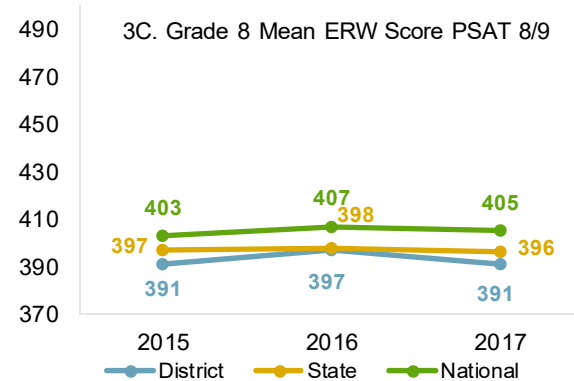
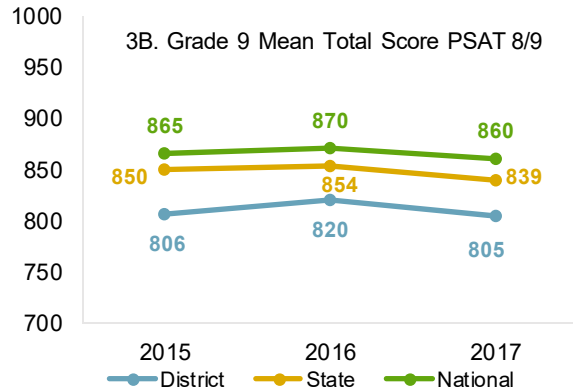
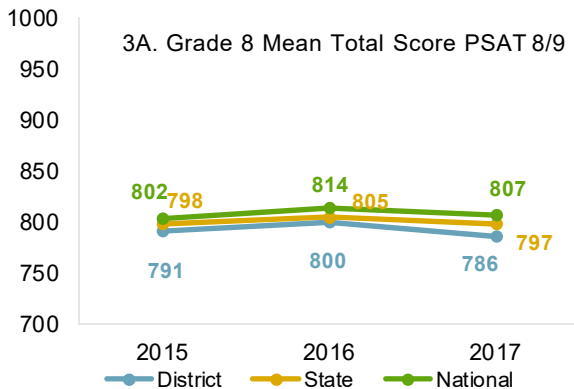
From fall 2016 to fall 2017, the number and the percentage of students taking the PSAT increased across all grade levels with the exception of grade 8 where the number of students taking the PSAT decreased slightly (**Figures 1–2**, p. 3).

**Figure 1. PSAT Participation by Grade****Figure 2. PSAT Participation Rate by Grade**

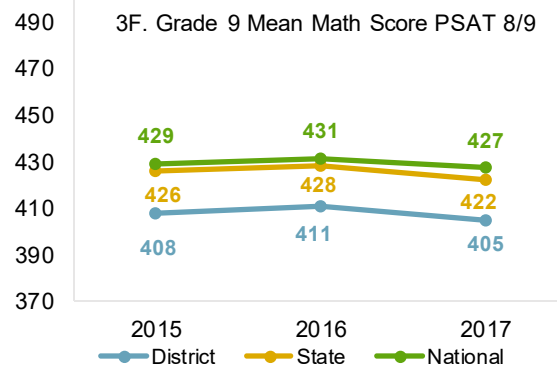
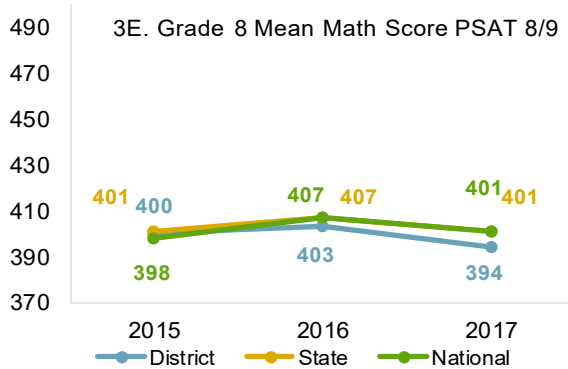

### How well did students perform on the PSAT?

Scores on the PSAT 8/9 range from 120 to 720 points on each of the two sections for a total score between 240 and 1440. HISD 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> graders scored slightly lower in fall 2017 compared to fall 2016 in both ERW and math (**Figures 3A–3F**, pp. 3–4).

**Figures 3A–3F. Mean PSAT 8/9 Scores of District, State, and National Students, 2015–2017**

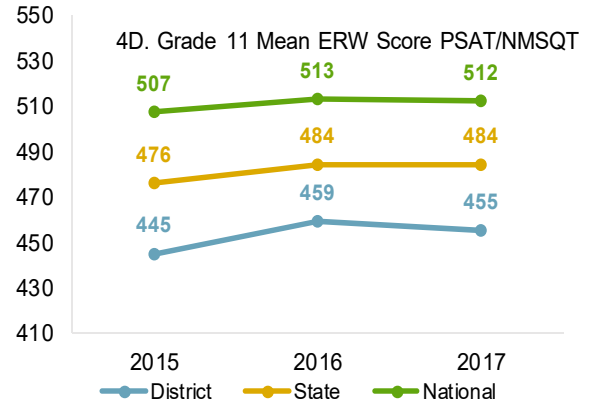
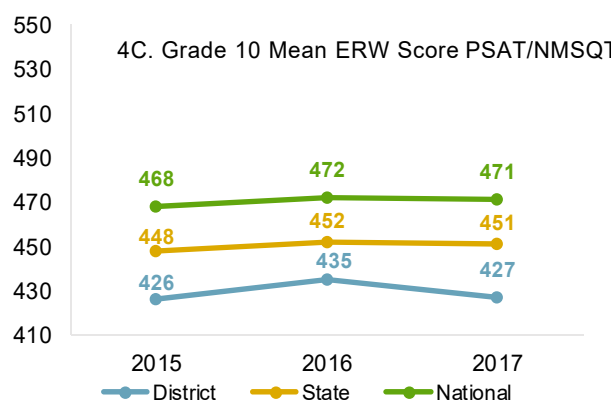
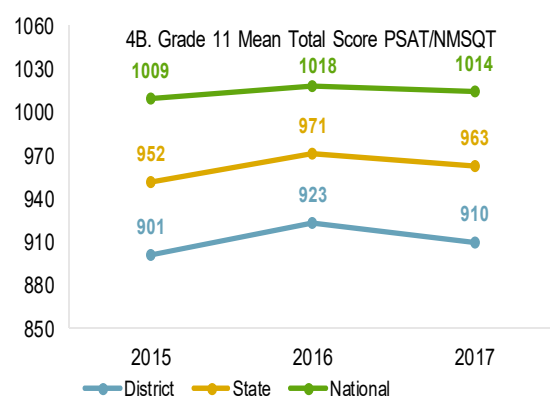
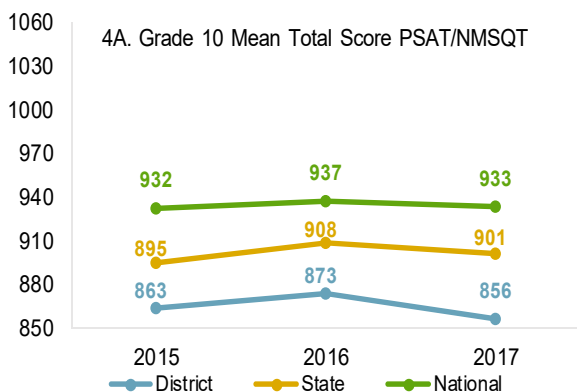




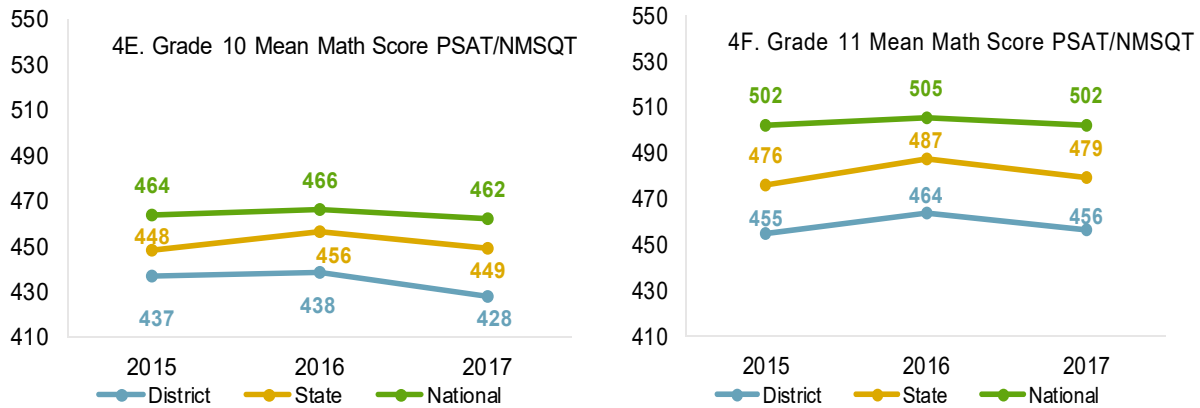

**Figures 4A–4F** (pp. 4–5) display the mean PSAT/NMSQT Composite and subject scores for HISD, Texas, and the nation for fall 2015 through fall 2017. Each subject on the PSAT/NMSQT is scored from 160 to 760, and total scores range from 320 to 1520. Figures 4A and 4B show that the average total score for students who took the exam in fall 2017 was 856 for tenth-graders and 910 for eleventh-graders, both of which are lower than in fall 2016. Average scores were lower for HISD students compared to those for the state and nation.

**Figures 4A–4F. Mean PSAT/NMSQT Scores of District, State, and National Students, 2015–2017**



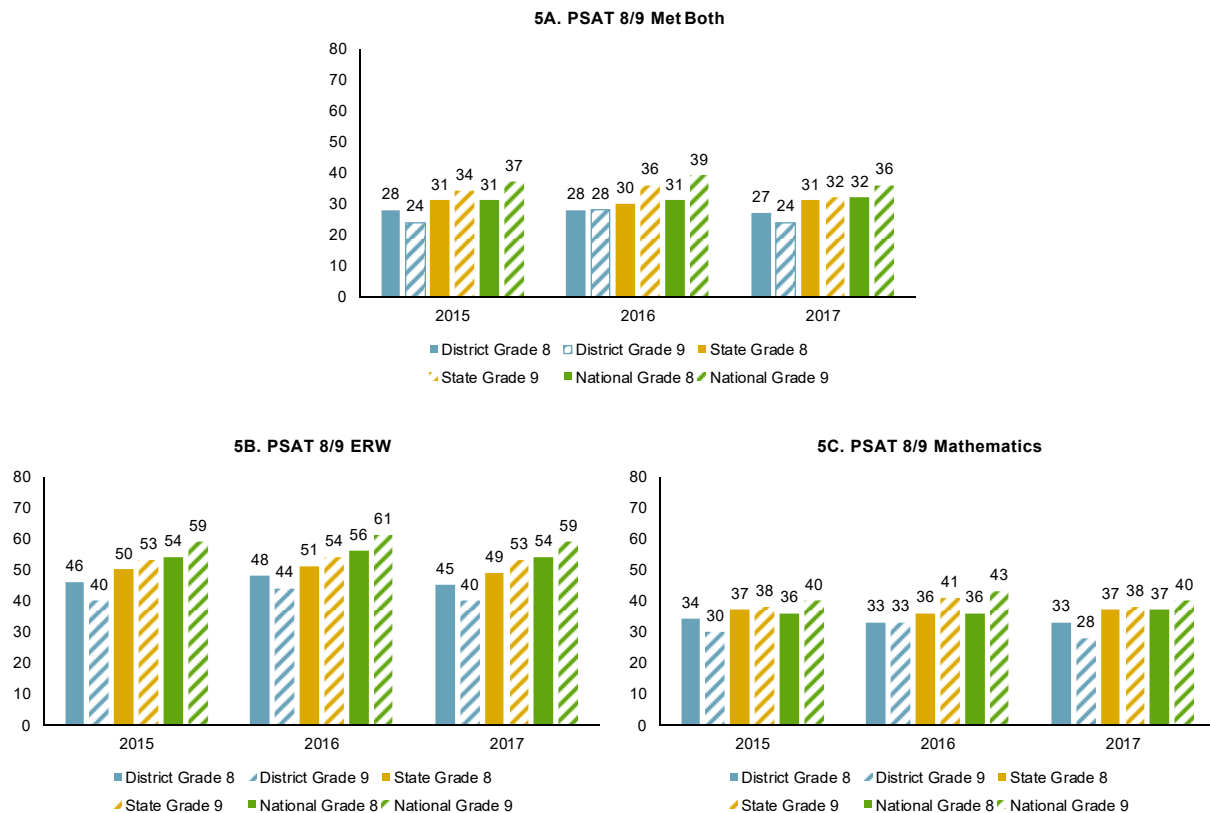

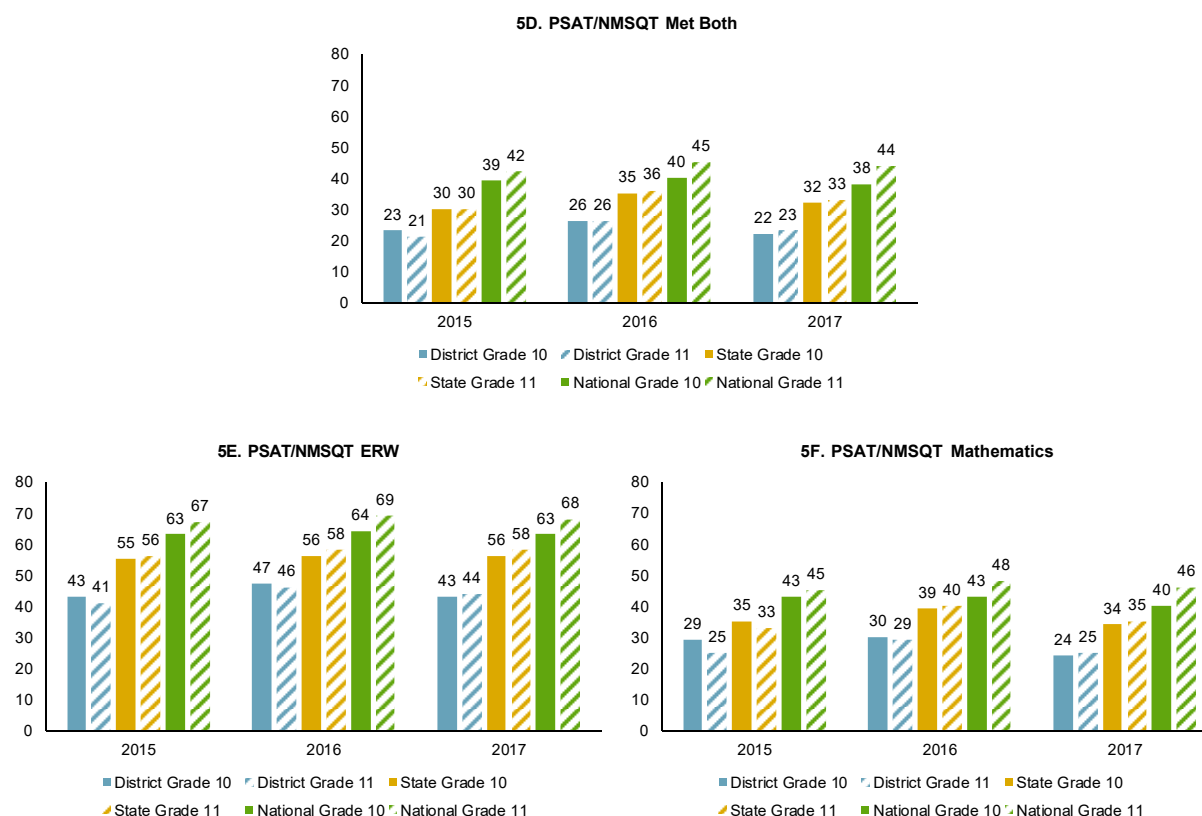
**Figure 5A–5C. Percentage of District, State, and National Students Meeting PSAT 8/9 CCR Benchmarks, 2015–2017**

The College Board sets College and Career Readiness (CCR) benchmarks for students who took the PSAT. These are the scores that students should meet or exceed to be considered on track to be college or career ready. **Figures 5A–5C** show the proportion of students who met the PSAT 8/9 benchmarks. In fall 2017, 27 percent of 8<sup>th</sup> graders and 24 percent of 9<sup>th</sup> graders met the benchmarks in both subjects. A higher percentage of students met the ERW benchmark than the math benchmark.

**Figures 5D–5F** show the proportion of students who met the PSAT/NMSQT benchmarks. In fall 2017, 22 percent of 10<sup>th</sup> graders and 23 percent of 11<sup>th</sup> graders met the benchmarks in both subjects. Similar to the PSAT 8/9 results, a higher percentage of students met the ERW benchmark than the math benchmark.

**Figure 5D–5F. Percentage of District, State, and National Students Meeting PSAT/NMAQT CCR Benchmarks, 2015–2017**



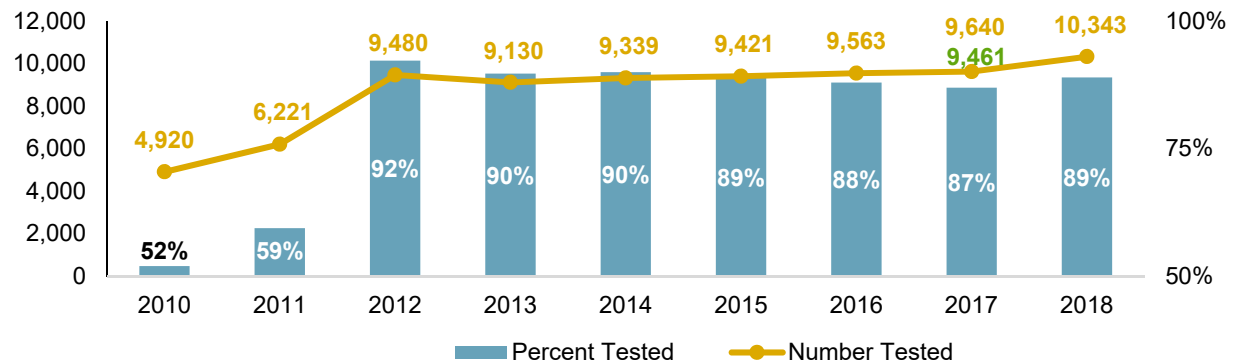

## SAT

The SAT is a college-entrance exam developed by the College Board that measures developed verbal and mathematical reasoning abilities related to successful performance in college. The test was redesigned in March 2016 to only include two sections: Evidence-Based Reading and Writing (ERW) and Mathematics. The data presented in this section reflect performance of graduating seniors for each year, as self-reported by students to the College Board when they took the exam.

### How many students participated in the SAT?

**Figure 6** (p. 7) shows that 10,343 HISD students in the Class of 2018 took the SAT, which represents 89 percent of students. The number of students taking the SAT continues to increase while the percentage of students taking the SAT has remained somewhat flat due to increased student enrollment.

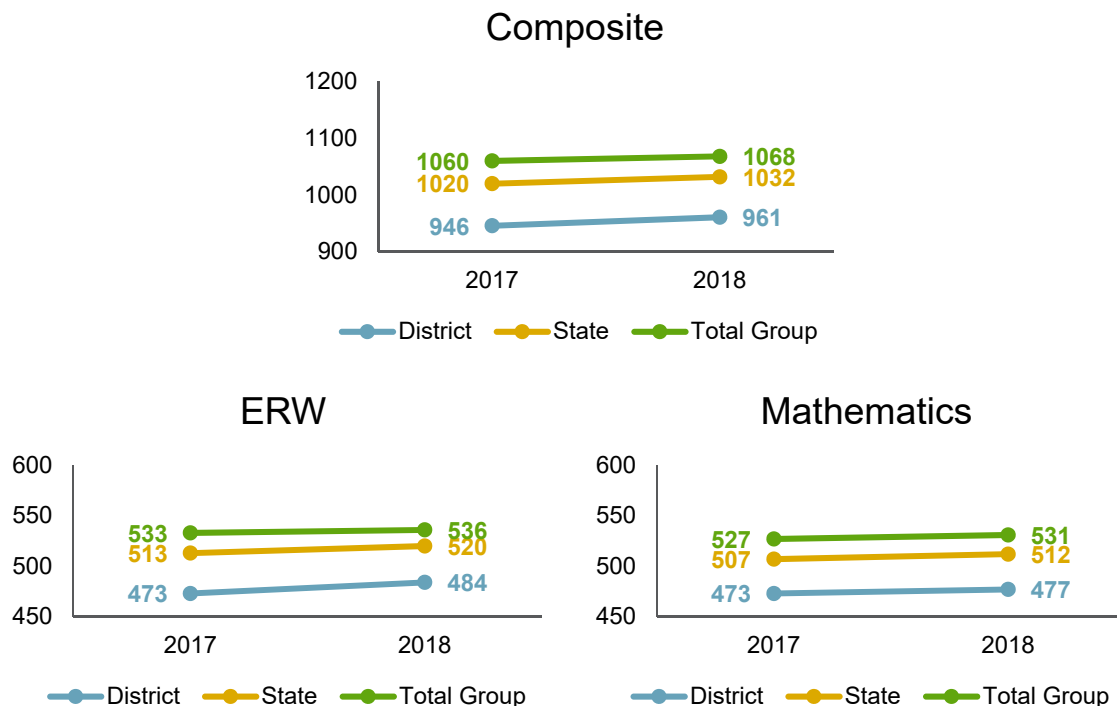
**Figure 6. HISD SAT Exam Participation, Classes of 2010–2018**

#### How well did students perform on the SAT?

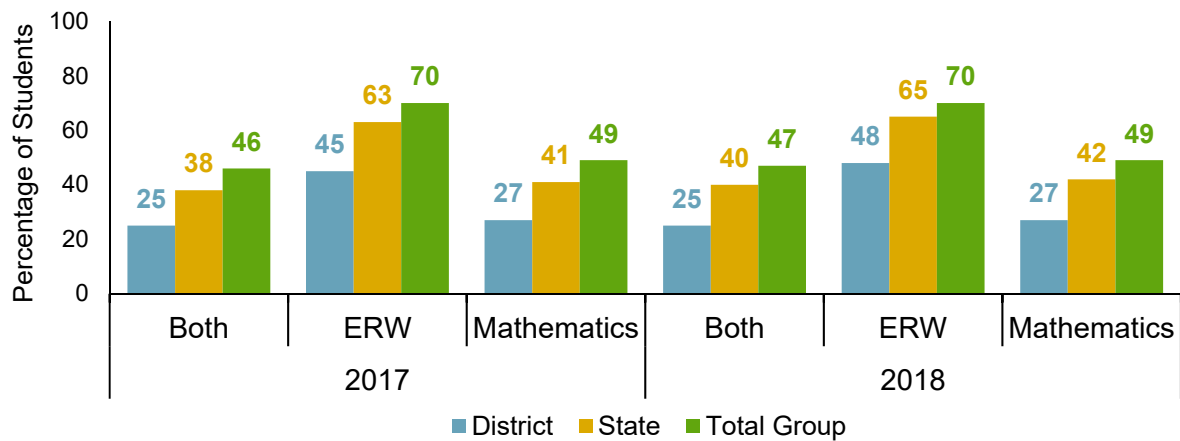
**Figure 7. Average SAT Scores of District, State, and Total Group Students, Classes of 2017–2018**

Each subject on the SAT is scored from 200 to 800, and composite scores on the redesigned exam range from 400 to 1600. **Figure 7** shows average subject scores for HISD students compared to the state and the total group (which includes international testers) on the redesigned test only. While a few students from the Class of 2017 took the old version of the SAT, the vast majority took the new version. Because comparing the redesigned exam with prior versions is problematic, performance data are only included for the Class of 2017 on the redesigned exam. HISD's Class of 2018 scored slightly higher than HISD's Class of 2017, but their scores were lower than those of the state and total group. However, the increases shown in the composite and ERW scores were higher for the district than for the state and total group.

The College Board sets college readiness benchmarks for the SAT to predict students' chance of success in college. The percentage of HISD students meeting the ERW benchmark increased from 45 percent in 2017 to 48 percent in 2018, but the percentage of HISD students meeting the mathematics and both benchmarks stayed the same. In addition, HISD lags compared to the state and total group (**Figure 8**).

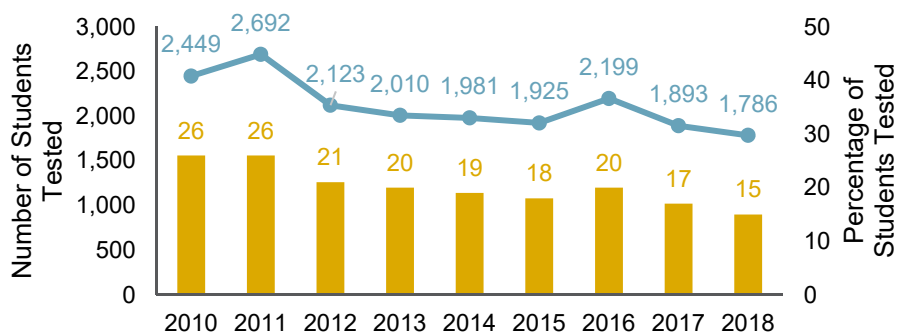
### ACT

The ACT is a college admissions exam that tests four subjects: English, Math, Reading, and Science. The ACT is offered six times per year and is typically taken by juniors and seniors. The data presented in this section reflect performance of graduating seniors for each year, as self-reported by students when they took the exam.

#### How many students participated in the ACT?

The ACT is not as popular among HISD students as the SAT. **Figure 9** indicates that 1,786 students from the Class of 2018 took the ACT, which is 15 percent of the class. Participation on the ACT has declined over the past three years.

**Figure 9. HISD ACT Test Participation, Classes of 2010–2018**

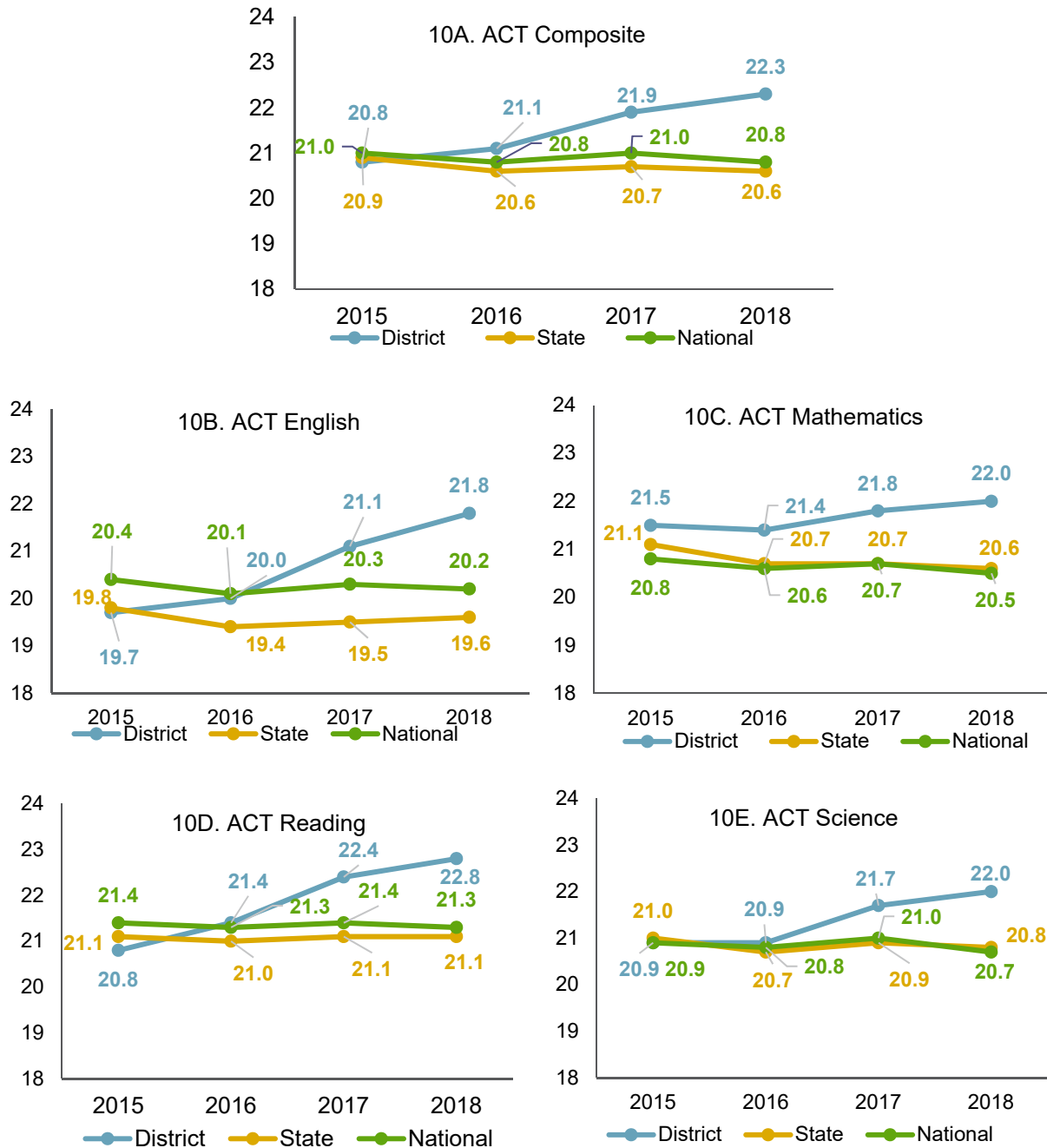

### How well did students perform on the ACT?

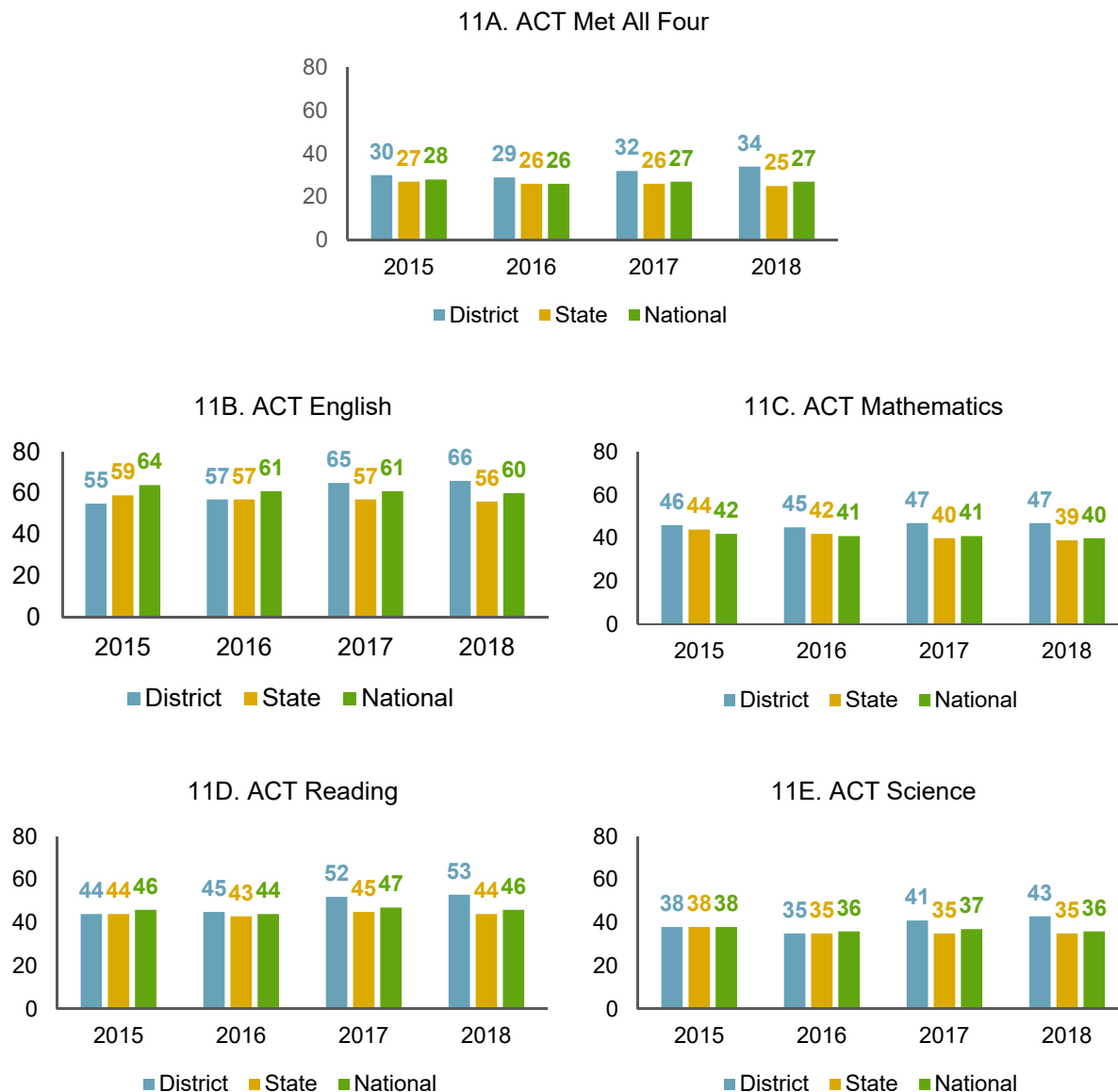
**Figures 10A–10E. Average ACT Scores of District, State, and National Students, Classes of 2015–2018**

Each subject on the ACT is scored from 1 to 36, and composite scores are an average of scores earned on the four subjects. **Figures 10A–10E** show that HISD's overall scores continue to increase and outpace those of the state and nation.

The ACT has also identified college readiness benchmarks. A student who earns or exceeds scores of 18 in English, 22 in Math, 22 in Reading, and 23 in Science is considered to be ready to succeed in college courses after high school. **Figures 11A–11E** show the proportion of students who met the benchmarks by subject from the Classes of 2015 through 2018. HISD's Class of 2018 had a higher percentage (34 percent) that met all four benchmarks compared to the state and nation for the fourth year in a row. In 2018, the greatest percentage of students met the benchmark for English (66 percent), and the lowest percentage met the benchmark for science (43 percent).

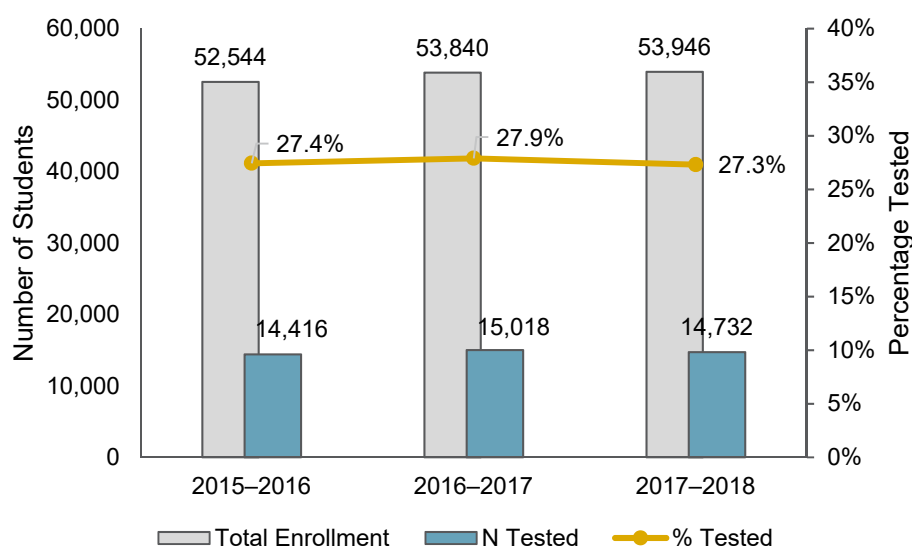
### Advanced Placement (AP)

The College Board's Advanced Placement (AP) Program provides participating high school students with the opportunity to take college-level courses and earn college credit, advanced placement, or both. A total of 38 examinations in Arts, Capstone (new in 2014–2015), English, History and Social Science, Mathematics and Computer Science, Sciences, and World Languages and Cultures are administered in May. The AP Program represents a critical element in HISD's efforts to inject rigor into high school classrooms. Since 2009, the AP course offerings in HISD have been vastly expanded, with more campuses offering a wider selection of AP courses that exposes a larger percentage of the high school population to academic rigor.

#### How many students participated in AP exams?

**Figure 12** shows the number of students enrolled in grades 9–12 and the number and percentage of students who took at least one AP exam.

**Figure 12. Number of Students Enrolled and Tested, Grades 9–12, 2015–2016 through 2017–2018**

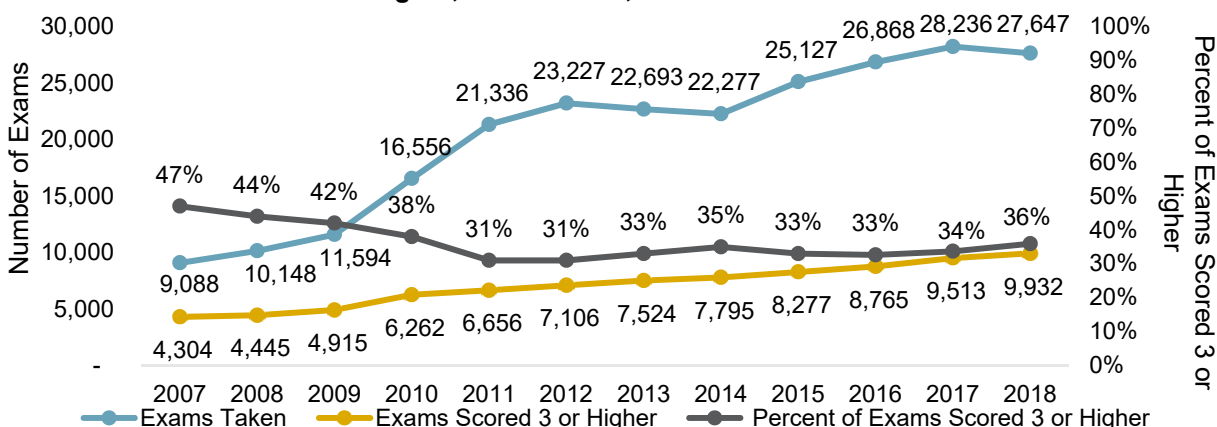

#### How well did students perform on AP exams?

Each AP exam is scored from 1 to 5. Students require a score of 3 or higher to “pass” the AP exam and potentially earn college credit. **Figure 13** (p. 12) shows the number of AP exams taken, the number of exams with a score of 3 or higher, and the percentage of exams with a score of 3 or higher. From 2017 to 2018, the number of exams taken decreased slightly, but the number and percentage of exams scored 3 or higher increased.

**Table 1** shows the percentage of AP Exams that received a score of 3 or higher by subject. Students who took AP Exams in AP Capstone and World Languages & Culture were most likely to earn a score of 3 or higher.

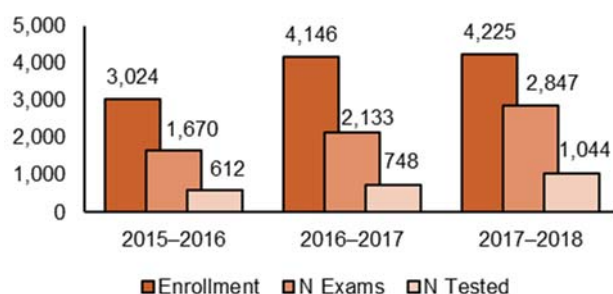
### International Baccalaureate (IB)

The IB Diploma Programme is a two-year course of study that prepares students for college and is recognized and accepted by universities around the world. Similar to the AP program, students with high scores on IB Exams can earn college credit or advanced placement at a college or university. Students participating in the IB Diploma Programme are required to take six exams in the following subjects: Literature, Language, Social Science, Experimental Science, Mathematics, and Art. Students may also choose to take individual IB courses and IB exams instead of participating in the full diploma program.

#### How many students participated in IB exams?

Two HISD high schools participated in the IB Programme through 2015–2016: Bellaire and Lamar High Schools. In 2016–2017, Heights High School also participated in the IB Programme. The total number of students who took IB exams increased to 1,044 students and the number of exams taken increased to 2,847 in 2017–2018 (**Figure 14**, p. 13).

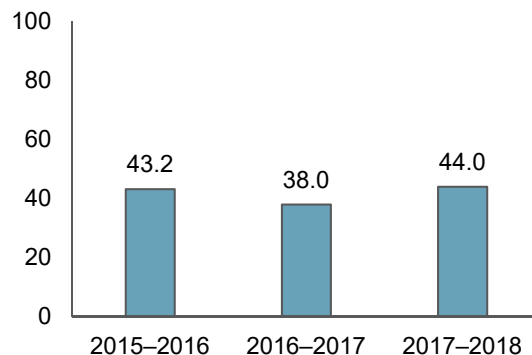

#### How well did students perform on IB exams?

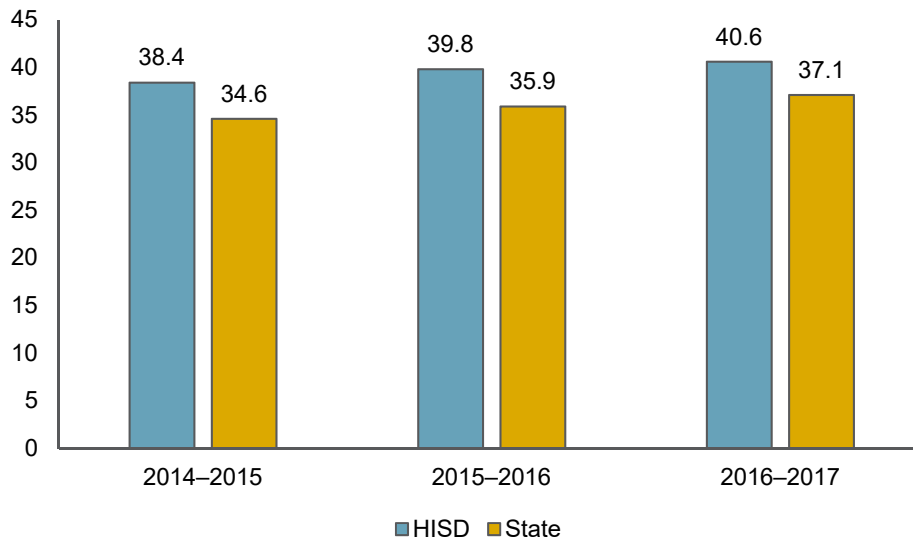
**Figure 15. Percentage of IB Exams Scored 4 or higher, 2015–2016 through 2017–2018**

Each IB exam is scored from 1 to 7. A score of 4 or higher is required to “pass” the IB exam and potentially earn college credit. **Figure 15** shows that the percentage of IB exams that received a score of 4 or higher has increased in 2017–2018 after a decrease in 2016–2017.

#### Advanced Course/Dual Credit Completion

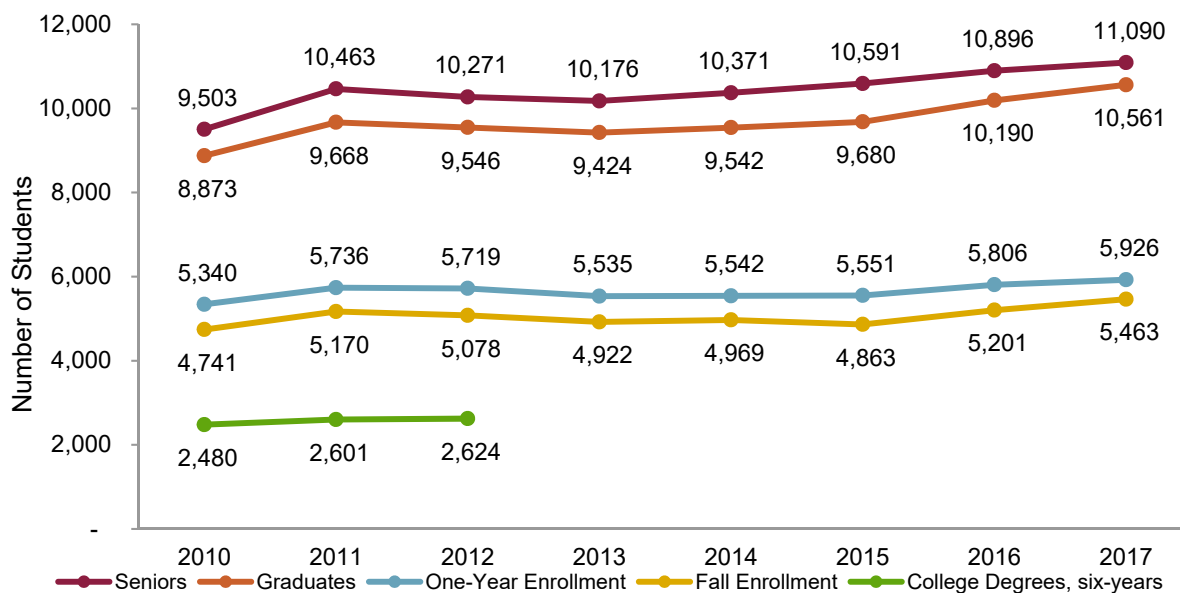
In addition to the use of assessments, college readiness can also be determined through enrollment in and completion of advanced and dual credit courses. Advanced courses include AP and IB courses along with other courses designated by the Texas Education Agency. A dual credit course is a college course taken by a high school student where the student earns both college and high school credit, which saves the student money and time toward college degrees before finishing high school. Students must meet certain eligibility requirements in order to participate in dual credit. Students who enroll and perform well in advanced/dual credit courses are not only college-ready but also are college-proven. In 2016–2017 (most current state data available), 40.6 percent of HISD students in grades 9–12 had completed at least one advanced/dual credit course in any subject, which is 3.5 percentage points higher than the state average (**Figure 16**, p. 14).

**Figure 16. Percentage of Students that Completed at Least One Advanced/Dual Credit Course for HISD and the State, 2014–2015 Through 2016–2017**

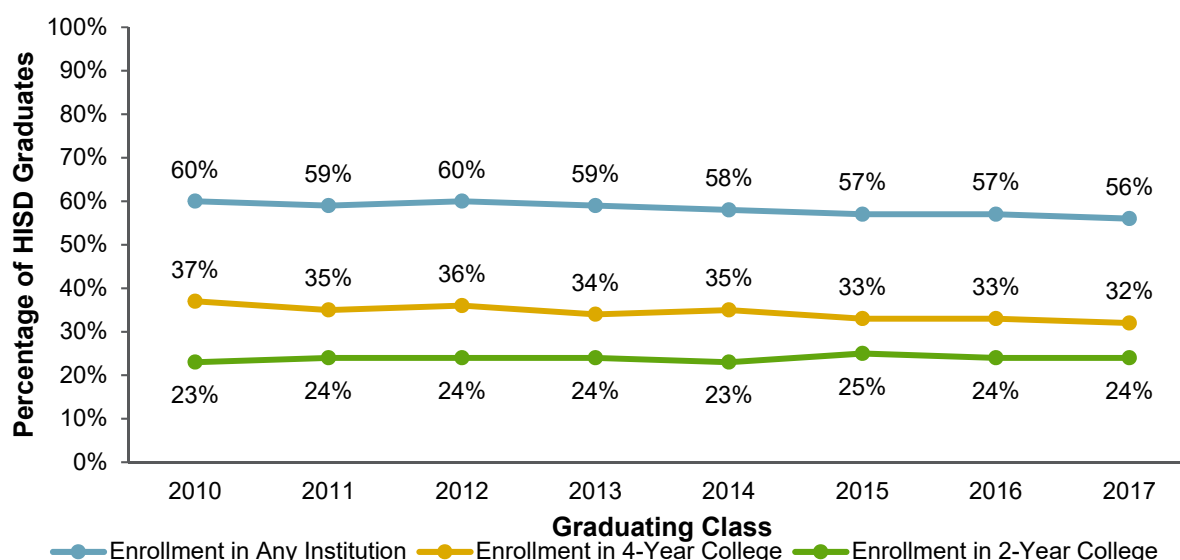

### Postsecondary Enrollment

The number of HISD graduates who enroll in college within one year of graduating from high school has increased by 11 percent from 5,340 to 5,926 between the Classes of 2010 and 2017 (**Figure 17**). The percentage of students enrolling in college within one year of graduation has declined since 2010 reaching 56 percent for the Class of 2017 (**Figure 18**, p. 15).

## Conclusion

In 2014, Houston ISD launched its Global Graduate Initiative. The district's and initiative's goal is to ensure that each HISD student graduates ready for the world. The profile of an HISD Global Graduate is one of a leader, a skilled communicator, adaptable and productive, a critical thinker, a responsible decision maker, and a college-ready learner. While this is a relatively new initiative, the goal of preparing students to be college and career ready upon graduation is not a new one for the district, which is why HISD has significantly increased participation in college readiness and entrance assessments since 2009 with the implementation and expansion of programs such as SAT School Day and funding both the cost of PSAT exams for freshmen and sophomores and AP Exams for all students.

These assessments measure a variety of skills and competencies, the mastery of which has proven to correlate with student success in both college and career. These assessments also help to track student preparation and progress. The PSAT 8/9 exam helps outline areas in which students might require additional support and areas in which students have demonstrated proficiency. Such feedback can help students focus their efforts and develop critical skills. It will continue to aid students early on and prepare them for critical exams such as PSAT/NMSQT and SAT.

Definitions of college readiness are quickly encompassing more than just a score on one assessment. In fact, to be considered both college and career ready, students may demonstrate performance on the State of Texas Assessments of Academic Readiness End-of-Course assessments (STAAR EOC), Texas Success Initiative (TSI), SAT, or ACT. Another way to prove college readiness is to take AP, IB, and dual credit courses which provide students with the opportunity to earn both high school and college credit upon course completion. Approximately 40 percent of HISD students enrolled in grades 9–12 completed one of these courses in 2016–2017.

As the key findings of this report indicate, more HISD students are taking college readiness and entrance assessments, but the participation rates remain relatively flat. Performance on the SAT, ACT, AP, and IB exams has improved while overall performance on PSAT exams decreased in the last year. In addition to a larger number of students taking college readiness assessments, more HISD students are also enrolling in and graduating from college or university. While this is a positive trend, the college enrollment rates upon high school graduation have decreased over time. The data presented in this report indicate that more can be done to increase the number of HISD students equipped to succeed in postsecondary education.

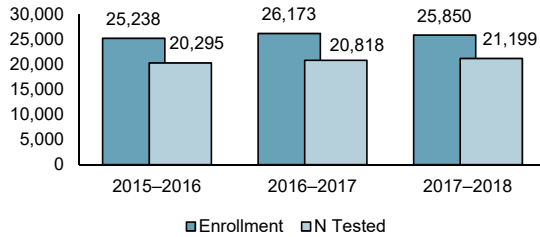

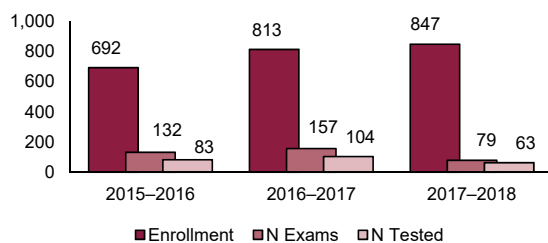

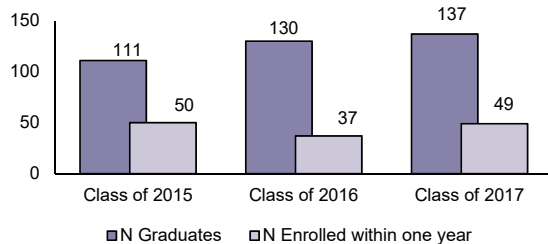

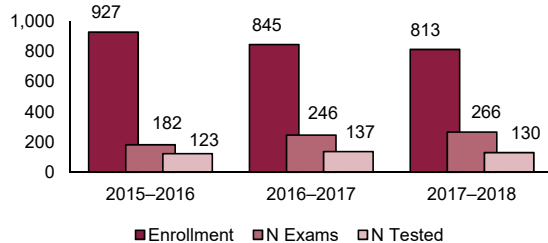

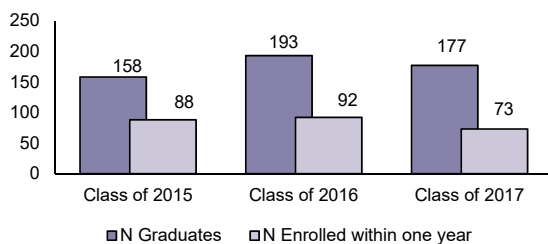

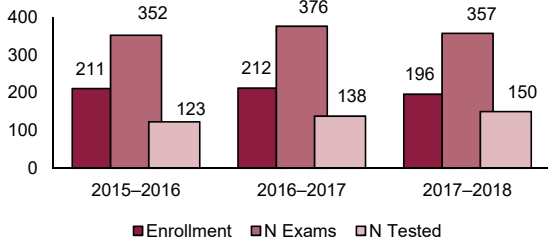

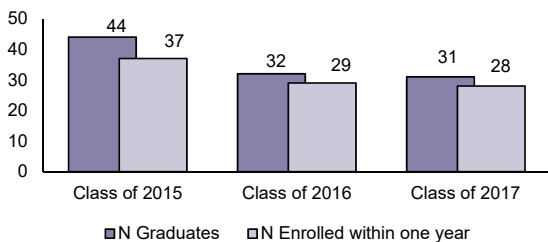
