SUBJECT: **DISTRICT AND SCHOOL RESULTS OF THE STUDENT SUCCESS INITIATIVE FROM THE APRIL 2010 MATH & READING TAKS FIRST ADMINISTRATION FOR GRADES 5 AND 8**

This memo provides complete two-year district level comparisons of the first administration of the Texas Assessment of Knowledge and Skills (TAKS), TAKS-Accommodated (TAKS-A) and TAKS-Modified (TAKS-M) results. The TAKS-M is an alternate assessment administered to students with disabilities.

The Student Success Initiative (SSI) was created by the Texas Legislature in 1999 to ensure that all students receive the instruction and support they need to be academically successful in reading and mathematics. During the 81st Texas Legislature in 2009, the Student Success Initiative (SSI) grade advancement requirements were modified to exclude grade 3 TAKS reading and apply only to the TAKS reading and mathematics tests at grades 5 and 8. Under the SSI grade advancement requirements, students are required to pass the Texas Assessment of Knowledge and Skills (TAKS) grade 5 reading and mathematics tests to be promoted to sixth grade. Additionally, students are required to pass the TAKS grade 8 reading and mathematics tests to be promoted to ninth grade.

The first administration of the Texas Assessment of Knowledge and Skills (TAKS) mathematics and reading tests to students in fifth and eighth grade were given on April 6-7, 2010. If unsuccessful after the first administration, students will receive additional state-mandated instruction and will take the tests they have not passed again on May 18-19, 2010. A Grade Placement Committee (GPC) will address students unsuccessful on the second administration of the reading and/or math sections of the TAKS. The GPC will create an educational plan based on the instructional needs of each student. These students will be given a third opportunity to pass the TAKS during summer school on June 29-30, 2010.

Fifth-and-eighth grade students who do not pass the reading and math TAKS after the third opportunity will automatically be retained. However, parents can appeal these results to the GPC, and the committee may decide to promote an individual student if there is consensus that the student is likely to succeed in the next grade.

Results

Results from students who took the English TAKS or TAKS-A grades 5 and 8 mathematics and reading or Spanish TAKS or TAKS-A grade 5 mathematics and reading results are presented in this memo. **Tables 1-4** present the math and reading results from the April 2010 English and Spanish TAKS of the fifth graders for overall student performance and for student groups. **Tables 5 & 6** present the math and reading results from the April 2010 English TAKS of the eighth graders for overall student performance and for student groups. **Tables 7-10** present the math and reading results from the April 2010 English TAKS-Modified of the fifth and eighth

grade students. The current year's April districtwide performance is compared to the first administration results from 2009 for overall student performance and for student group outcomes.

- For the Student Success Initiative, the most pragmatic comparison involves contrasting student performance on the passing and commended standards for current and prior years. A total of 85% of HISD fifth-graders met the passing standard on the English math TAKS in April of 2010, a 1 percentage-point increase from 84% in April of 2009. Forty percent of HISD fifth-graders met the commended standard in April of 2010, which demonstrated a decrease of 4 percentage points from 44% in April of 2009.
- All of the fifth-grade student groups from April 2010 exhibited increases in passing rates when compared with the 2009 results. The largest increase was from the Special Education students whose percentage increased by 3 percentage points. The smallest increase was from white students whose percentage increased by 1 percentage point.
- The average scale scores improved by 4 points from 694 in 2009 to 698 in 2010 for all fifth-graders. Improvement in scale scores was found for all student groups except for the Special Education group that decreased by 1 point. The largest increase among student groups was achieved by the White student group with an 8 point improvement from 744 in 2009 to 752 in 2010.

- On the 2010 first administration, 81% of HISD fifth-graders met the passing standard on the English reading TAKS compared to 79% in 2009.
- The majority of the student groups in April 2010 exhibited an increase in passing rates compared to 2009. The largest increase was found for the Special Education student group increasing from 56% passing to 61% passing. The White student group remained constant from the year before at 96%.
- The percent commended increased for all fifth-grade students on the English reading TAKS and all of the student groups except for White students, which remained constant. The highest increase was among Hispanic students and Limited English Proficient (LEP) students with a 6-percentage point increase.
- The average scale scores improved by 6 points from 686 in 2009 to 692 in 2010 for all fifth-graders. Improvements in scale scores were found in each student group except for White students, which decreased by 15 points. The highest increase was among LEP students where the average score increased by 13 points from 638 in 2009 to 651 in 2010.

- In April of 2010, 67% of HISD fifth-graders met the passing standard on the Spanish math TAKS, which was an increase of 35 percentage points from 32% in April of 2009. The number of students tested however, declined by approximately 50 percent.
- The percent of fifth-grade students taking the Spanish TAKS math test that reached the commended level increased from 7% in April of 2009 to 14% in April 2010 for all students. The average scale score for all students increased by 49 points from 587 in 2009 to 636 in 2010.
- The percent of Economically Disadvantaged students taking the Spanish TAKS mathematics test that met standard increased by 42 percentage points from 32% in 2009 to 74% in 2010. The Economically Disadvantaged group increased the percent commended by 7 percentage points from 2009 to 2010. It should be noted that only 19 students were tested on fifth-grade Spanish version of the test.

- On the Spanish TAKS, 85% of HISD fifth-graders met the reading passing standard in April 2010, an increase from 69% in 2009.
- The percent of fifth-grade students taking the Spanish TAKS reading test that reached the commended level increased from 8% in April of 2009 to 11% in April 2010 for all students. The fifth-grade students taking the Spanish TAKS reading test increased their average scale score by 11 points from 653 in 2009 to 664 in 2010 for all students.
- The percent of Economically Disadvantaged students taking the Spanish TAKS reading test that met standard increased by 14 percentage points from 70% in 2009 to 84% in 2010. The Economically Disadvantaged group increased the percent commended by 4 percentage points from 2009 to 2010.

Tables 5 and 6 present the math and reading results from the April 2010 English TAKS or TAKS-A for overall student performance and for the student groups of the eighth grade. The 2009 TAKS first administration results are provided for comparison purposes.

- On the English TAKS math in April of 2010, 75% of HISD eighth-graders met the passing standard with an increase of 3 percentage points from 72% in April of 2009. The percent commended increased for all students from 19% in 2009 to 20% in 2010.
- Most of the eighth-grade student groups from April 2010 exhibited increases in passing rates when compared with the 2009 results. Only the white student group had a slight decline from 90% in 2009 to 88% in 2010. The largest increase was shown by the LEP students whose percent increased by 6 percentage points.
- The percent commended increased for most eighth-grade student groups on the math TAKS from 2009 to 2010, with the exception of the white student group that had a decrease of 2 percentage points from 2009. The African American group as well as the Special Education group remained constant. The largest increase was 1 percentage point and that was made by the Hispanic, Economically Disadvantaged, and LEP groups.
- The All Students average scale score in mathematics improved by 13 points from 746 in 2009 to 759 in 2010 with all eighth-grade student groups showing increases. The LEP students demonstrated the largest increase with a 17-point gain.

- On the 2010 first administration, 87% of HISD eighth-graders met the passing standard on the English reading TAKS, a decrease of two percentage points from the previous year.
- Most of the seven student groups from April 2010 performed at or below the rates from 2009. The performance by White and LEP students remained constant, while the other student groups decreased. The largest decrease occurred with the African American, Hispanic, and Economically Disadvantaged groups with a decrease of 3 percentage points each.
- The percent commended decreased or remained the same for all student groups except the Special Education subgroup which increased by 1 percentage point. The Hispanic student group had the largest decrease of 5 percentage points from 2009.
- The All Students average scale scores in reading improved by 16 points from 781 in 2009 to 797 in 2010. Each student group improved their score from the previous year. The LEP student group demonstrated the largest increase with a 34-point improvement.

School-level results: Data are included for fifth and eighth-grade performance on the English TAKS or TAKS-A mathematics and reading for the past two years. The following notable results were found.

- In 2010, the district percentage of fifth-grade students meeting the English mathematics standard was 85%. The following schools scored at a 99% or higher passing rate: Bush Elementary, Cornelius Elementary, Horn Elementary, Oak Forest Elementary, Roberts Elementary, T. H. Rogers, Scott Elementary, Seguin Elementary, E. O. Smith Education Center, and West University Elementary.
- In 2010, the district percentage of fifth-grade students meeting the English reading standard was 81%. The following schools scored at a 99% or higher passing rate: Bush Elementary, Oak Forest Elementary, Roberts Elementary, and Ross Elementary.

- In 2010, the district percentage of eighth-grade students meeting the mathematics standard was 75%. The following schools scored at a 99% or higher passing rate: Briar Meadow Charter School, Energized for Excellence Middle School, and T.H. Rogers.
- In 2010, the district percentage of eighth-grade students meeting the English reading standard was 87%. The following schools scored at a 99% or higher passing rate: Briar Meadow Charter School, Energized for Excellence Middle School, Lanier Middle School, Pin Oak Middle School, Rice School, T.H. Rogers, Rusk School, and William A. Lawson Institute for Peace and Prosperity (WALIPP).

Tables 7-10 present the results from April 2010 English TAKS-Modified mathematics and reading for the fifth and eighth grade students in mathematics.

- On the TAKS-Modified version of the test in 2010, the district percentage of fifth-grade students meeting the English mathematics standard increased by 8 percentage points from 74% in 2009 to 82% in 2010. The Economically Disadvantaged group increased their percent passing by 6 percentage points from 75% in 2009 to 81% in 2010.
- The district percentage of fifth-grade students that achieved commended performance was 21%, which was a decrease of 5 percentage points from 2009. Twenty percent of the Economically Disadvantaged group achieved commended performance in April 2010. This was a 7 percentage point decrease from 2009.

- On the TAKS-Modified version of the test in 2010, the district percentage of fifth-grade students meeting the English reading standard increased by 10 percentage points from 77% in 2009 to 87% in 2010. The Economically Disadvantaged group also increased their percent passing by 10 percentage points from 77% in 2009 to 87% in 2010.

- The district percentage of fifth-grade students that achieved commended performance was 21%, which was an increase of 3 percentage points from 2009. Twenty percent of the Economically Disadvantaged group achieved commended performance in April 2010. This was a 2 percentage point increase from 2009.

- On the TAKS-Modified version of the test in 2010, the district percentage of eighth-grade students meeting the English mathematics standard increased by 2 percentage points from 57% in 2009 to 59% in 2010. The Economically Disadvantaged group also increased their percent passing by 2 percentage points from 57% in 2009 to 59% in 2010.
- The district percentage of eighth-grade students that achieved commended performance was 9%, which was an increase of 1 percentage point from 2009. Eight percent of the Economically Disadvantaged student group achieved commended performance in April 2010. This percent remained constant from 2009.



- On the TAKS-Modified version of the test in 2010, the district percentage of eighth-grade students meeting the reading standard increased by 5 percentage points from 74% in 2009 to 79% in 2010. The Economically Disadvantaged group increased their percent passing by 7 percentage points from 73% in 2009 to 80% in 2010.
- The district percentage of eighth-grade students that achieved commended performance was 17%, which was an increase of 6 percentage points from 2009. Seventeen percent of the Economically Disadvantaged group achieved commended performance in April 2010. This was an increase of 8 percentage points from 2009.

Students who did not pass the fifth or eighth-grade reading and/or mathematics TAKS tests in April will have two additional opportunities to pass the test to meet the state promotion standards

requirements under the SSI. Students who take the TAKS-M will also be given additional opportunities to meet the standard.
