SUBJECT: **DISTRICT AND SCHOOL RESULTS OF THE STUDENT SUCCESS INITIATIVE FROM THE APRIL 2006 MATH TAKS ADMINISTRATION FOR GRADE 5**

This report supersedes the April 27, 2006 report. School and administrative district data have been added for a complete analysis of the district's results.

Enacted by the 76th Texas Legislature in 1999, the Student Success Initiative's (SSI) goal is to ensure that all students receive the instruction and support they need to be academically successful in reading and mathematics. Grade advancement requirements were applied to the Grade 3 reading test starting in 2002–03, and to the Grade 5 reading and mathematics tests beginning with the 2004–05 school year. The SSI requirements will be phased in for the Grade 8 reading and mathematics tests beginning in the 2007–08 school year. As specified by these requirements, a student may advance to the next grade level only by passing these tests or by unanimous decision of his or her grade placement committee that the student is likely to perform at grade level after additional instruction.

The first administration of the Texas Assessment of Knowledge and Skills (TAKS) mathematics test to students in fifth grade was given on April 4, 2006. If unsuccessful after the first administration, students will receive additional state-mandated instruction and will take the math test again on May 16, 2006. A Grade Placement Committee (GPC) will address students unsuccessful on the second administration of the reading and/or math sections of the TAKS. The GPC will create an educational plan based on the instructional needs of each student. These students will be given a third opportunity to pass the TAKS during summer school on June 27–28, 2006. Fifth-grade students who do not pass the reading and math TAKS after the third opportunity will automatically be retained. However, parents can appeal these results to the GPC, and the committee may decide to promote an individual student if there is consensus that the student is likely to succeed in the next grade.

### Results

Last year, the SSI was expanded to include fifth-grade reading and math TAKS performance. The math districtwide results are presented in this memo with region and school-level data provided in the attachment. Third and fifth-grade reading results were distributed previously, but are shown in the attachment. **Tables 1–3** present the math results from the April 2006 English and Spanish TAKS for overall student performance and for student groups. The 2005 TAKS first administration results are provided for comparison purposes.

- For the Student Success Initiative, the most pragmatic comparison involves contrasting student performance on the passing standards for the past two years. Expressly, 67% of HISD fifth graders met the passing standard on the English math TAKS in April of 2005, while 74% met the passing standard in April of 2006. The remaining 3,515 fifth-graders, who did not pass, will take the math TAKS again in May.
- Each student group from April 2006, exhibited an increase in passing rates when the results of 2006 were compared with the 2005 results. The largest increase was the Special Education students who increased by 12 percentage points.
- Although the percent commended increased for all fifth-grade students on the math TAKS from 19% in 2005 to 29% in 2006, the largest increase was exhibited by white students with an increase of 13 percentage points.
- The average scale scores improved from 2005 to 2006 for all students from 2194 to 2239. Improvement in scale scores was found for each student group.

- Katrina and Rita evacuees made up 2% of the students taking the English fifth-grade math TAKS. The district overall passing rate increased 1% when Katrina/ Rita students were excluded from the counts.

- With the exception of the white students who scored eight percentage points behind their HISD cohort, other groups scored less than 50% across the board on meeting the TAKS standard.
- No Katrina/ Rita students took the Spanish version of the fifth-grade math TAKS.

- On the Spanish TAKS, expressly, 48% of HISD fifth graders met the Spanish TAKS passing standard in April of 2005, while 56% met the passing standard on the first administration in 2006. The remaining 80 students who did not pass will be tested again in May.
- The percent of fifth-grade students taking the Spanish TAKS math test that reached the commended level increased from 13% in spring 2005 to 15% in April 2006 for all students. The average scale score for all students remained the same.

The results from the April 2006 English and Spanish TAKS are presented in **Table 4** as the percentage of fifth-grade students passing math at the state standard and percent commended. Districtwide performance is compared to statewide results for overall student performance and for student groups.

- On the April 2006 TAKS first administration, the state had a higher overall passing rate with 81% of fifth graders passing the English math TAKS compared to the HISD passing rate of 74%.
- White fifth graders attending HISD schools had a higher passing rate in math, 94%, than the statewide cohort rate, 91%. HISD limited English proficient students outperformed the state cohort by two percentage points. The state's passing rate was higher in 2006 than HISD's for all the other student groups.
- For the 2006 English math TAKS, the state had a higher overall commended rate, with 38% of the fifth graders performing at that level, compared to the HISD commended rate of 29%. White HISD students reached the commended level at a higher rate than their statewide cohort with a rate of 59% compared to the state rate of 50%.
- On the April 2006 first administration Spanish TAKS, HISD fifth-grade students outperformed the statewide cohort in math. Specifically, the HISD passing rate for all fifth-grade students taking the Spanish TAKS was 56% as compared to the state passing rate of 47%.
- On the Spanish version of the fifth-grade TAKS math, HISD students outperformed the statewide level of commended performance, as well. Specifically, the HISD commended rate for all fifth-grade students taking the Spanish TAKS was 15%, as compared to the state commended rate of 12%.

Charts graphically depicting the above information are provided as attachments. Two years of HISD and state performance on TAKS math are compared for the fifth grade. Charts are presented for the percent passing and percent commended. School-level results are also included in the attached tables. Third-grade and fifth-grade reading and fifth-grade math results from the 2006 first administration of the TAKS in English and Spanish are presented. The following notable results were found.

- On the English fifth-grade math TAKS, 28 of the 186 schools, or 15%, with five or more students tested, had a passing rate of approximately 90% or better. Three schools, Briar Meadow, Port Houston, and T. H. Rogers Elementary School, had a passing rate of 100% on this first administration. Fifth graders at Bush, Horn, Kolter, Roosevelt, and West University elementary schools had passing rates of at least 97% or better.
- On the Spanish fifth-grade math TAKS, 2 of the 10 schools, or 20%, with five or more students tested, had a passing rate of approximately 85% or better. The two schools were Port Houston and Wharton elementary schools with passing rates of 85% and 87%, respectively.

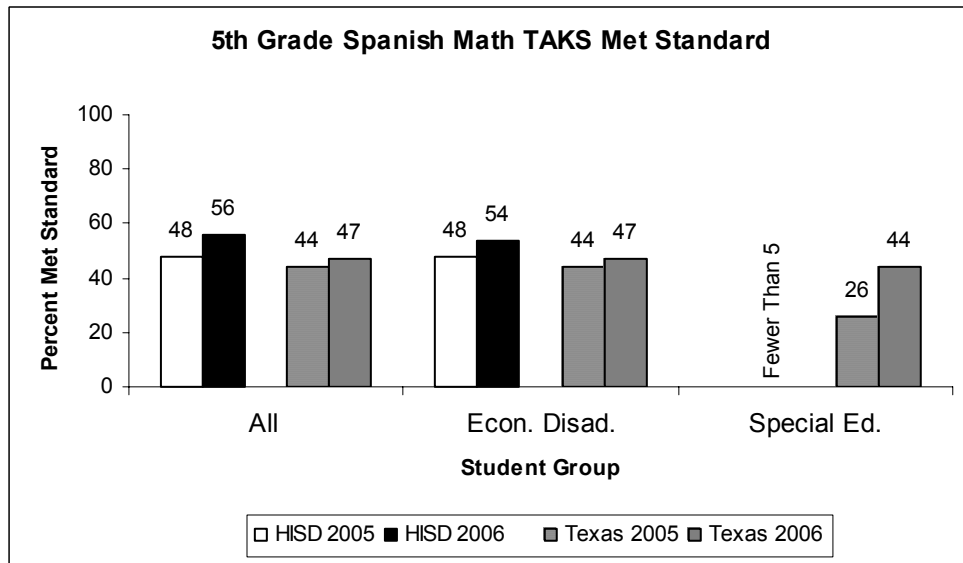
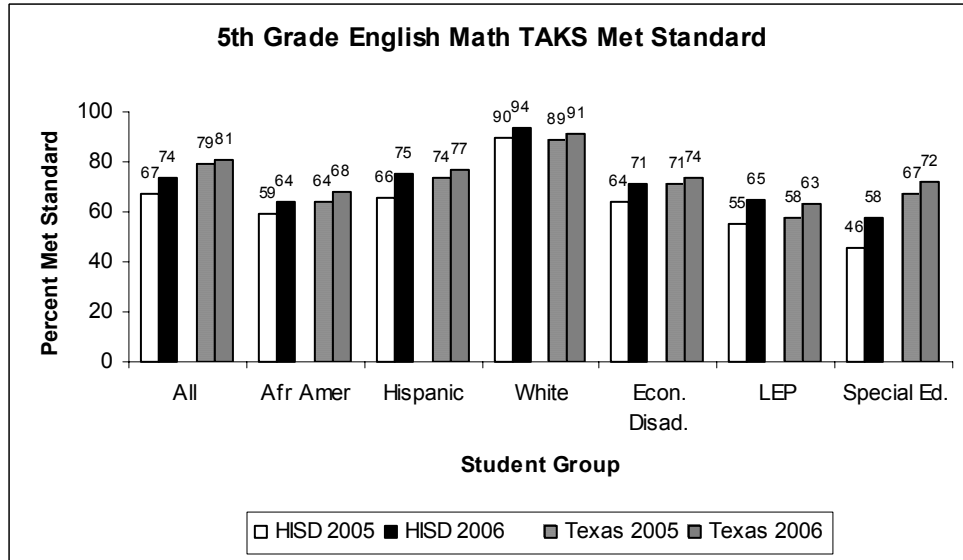
Students who did not pass the fifth-grade math test in April will have two additional opportunities to pass the test to meet the state promotion standard requirements under the SSI. Fifth graders will also have to pass the TAKS reading test under the SSI.

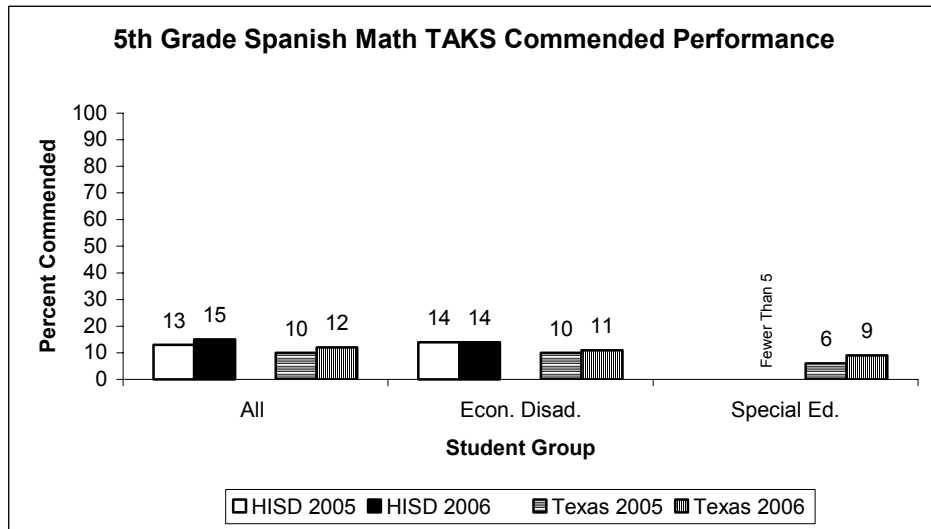
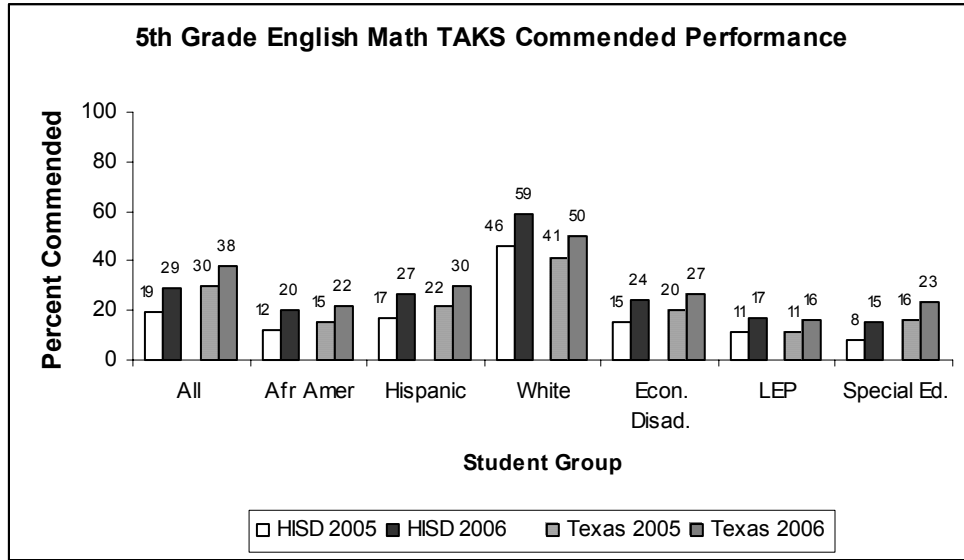
