SUBJECT: DISTRICT AND SCHOOL RESULTS FROM THE SPRING 2016 STAAR END-

OF-COURSE (EOC) ASSESSMENTS

In spring 2016, Houston ISD students took nearly 70,000 STAAR end-of-course (EOC) assessments in the following five subjects: Algebra I, Biology, English I, English II, and U.S. History. In general, students must pass the five STAAR EOC assessments in order to earn a high school diploma from a Texas public or charter school, as required in Texas Education Code (TEC) 39.025.

STAAR Exam Versions

In 2016, there are four versions of STAAR exams offered to students taking high school courses:

- STAAR is available to all students who do not qualify for one of the other STAAR assessments. Students with disabilities (SWD) may take the STAAR with accommodations at the discretion of the Admission, Review, and Dismissal (ARD) Committees.
- STAAR L is an online, linguistically accommodated English version of the STAAR assessments in Algebra I, Biology, and U.S. History. STAAR L is provided for English Language Learners (ELLs) who meet participation requirements for a substantial degree of linguistic accommodation in these subject areas.
- STAAR Accommodated (STAAR A) is the online assessment version of STAAR for students with disabilities that meet the STAAR A eligibility requirements. STAAR A provides embedded supports designed to help students with disabilities access the content being assessed. These embedded supports include visual aids, graphic organizers, and text-tospeech functionality.
- STAAR Alternate 2 (STAAR Alt. 2) STAAR Alt 2 is an assessment for students with significant cognitive disabilities receiving special education services.

STAAR Testing Incidents

The spring 2016 transition to the state's new testing vendor, Educational Testing Service (ETS) has been filled with publicized missteps and mistakes. The fifty Region 4 superintendents, as well as the Texas Association of School Administrators (TASA), recently submitted separate letters to Commissioner Morath detailing unacceptable "testing incidents in an effort to provide a detailed picture of the serious flaws in the current testing system." TASA summarized their findings into five categories: data validity and security, online testing incidents, communication, the shipping of testing materials, and other issues.

STAAR Standards

By commissioner's rule, the Level II Phase-in 1 Satisfactory standard was increased to the Level II Satisfactory 2016 progression standard and will continue to increase each year until 2021-22. This means that students taking an EOC for the first time will have to answer more items correctly to "pass" STAAR EOC exams than in the previous year; any student who has previously taken an EOC exam will be scored based on the Phase-In 1 standard in place at the student's first time of testing. Any comparisons to prior performance should be made with caution.

STAAR Administrations

All five STAAR EOC assessments required for graduation—Algebra I, Biology, English I, English II, and U.S. History—are administered at the end of the first semester (fall), at the end of the second semester (spring), and in the summer, giving students three testing opportunities each year.

The STAAR EOC assessment calendar is shown below and it displays the various districtwide tests administered during the spring of 2016. All STAAR tests have a four-hour time limit; however, students who meet eligibility criteria may have accommodations for extra time or an extra day.

Key Findings Include:

- The proportion of first-time tested students who passed the 2016 STAAR EOC ranged from 62% in English I to 92% in U.S. History.
- The proportion of first-time tested students who passed the 2016 STAAR EOC increased in three of the five subjects (English I, English II, and U.S. History) and remained steady in Algebra I and Biology when compared to spring 2015 results.

- Performance gaps between White and African-American students and White and Hispanic students for each subject in 2016 and the year in which the exam was first administered have decreased slightly and/or remained stable over time for Algebra I, Biology, English I and U.S. History.
- The percentages of students who met the Final Recommended and Advanced standard (Postsecondary Readiness) increased in all EOC subjects when compared to the 2015 results. First-time testers saw between four and six percentage-point improvements in the proportion of students performing at the Final Recommended standard and between one and four percentage-point improvements at the Advanced standard across all EOC content areas.

Specific administrative responses for HISD student support offices are listed below.

Administrative Responses to the 2016 STAAR EOC results:

Secondary Curriculum and Development

The Secondary Curriculum and Development team is pleased to see indications of growth on End Of Course tests this year, specifically on English I, English II, and U.S. History. Instructional coaching at schools during SY 2015-2016, combined with revisions to the HISD curriculum, and the development of Master Course lessons were new supports provided to HISD teachers. While EOC growth is promising, there is still much work to be done to increase the numbers of students in all subgroups performing at the advanced levels. The Secondary Curriculum and Development team will continue to support teachers through the development of aligned resources, professional learning for data-driven instruction and effective technology integration, and will include more professional learning opportunities to build proficiency with graphing calculators in Algebra I. Additionally, schools will receive additional support for literacy strategies to address reading, writing, listening, speaking, and thinking across all content areas at the secondary level.

Schools' Office This Year:

- Beginning of the year goal setting conferences were held with each Principal based on prior year's data.
- Ongoing progress monitoring through analysis of formative assessment data and goal progress reviews were held throughout the school year. During goal progress reviews, coaching was given, data was disaggregated and unpacked, and action plans were modified to support school-specific needs.
- Coaching and professional development sessions targeted towards school-specific needs in literacy were held throughout the year through Principal Meetings, PLCs, SSO check-ins, etc. Examples include genre-focused studies in ELA and Mild, Medium, and Spicy Writing Strategies.

Next Year:

- Schools Offices will place increased emphasis on effective utilization of the Scholastic Reading Inventory and its corresponding reports at all high school campuses. Whole-group Professional development sessions will be provided to all Principals and additional supports as needed to support implementation at particular campuses will be deployed as necessary.
- Professional Development sessions on best practices in literacy development and support at the Secondary-level as well as writing across the content areas.

Office Special Education Services

The Office of Special Education Services will continue to meet the needs of schools and students by:

- Providing guidance to relevant staff on increasing the participation of students with disabilities in the standard curriculum.
- Increasing the number of students who access grade level curriculum through the use of Universal Design for Learning (UDL) strategies and student specific accommodations.
- Utilizing Goalbook to create Individualized Education Plans (IEP) goals that are aligned with grade level curriculum (Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills).
- Creating a Full and Individualized Evaluation (FIE) summary page to inform teachers of student's cognitive strengths and instructional strategies to support those strengths.
- Implementing restorative discipline practices for students with and without disabilities to increase student engagement and participation in academic opportunities.

STATE OF TEXAS ASSESSMENTS OF ACADEMIC READINESS (STAAR) END-OF-COURSE RESULTS SPRING 2016



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District and School State of Texas Assessments of Academic Readiness (STAAR) End-of-Course, Spring 2016

Introduction

Texas has offered a statewide student assessment since 1980. In the spring of 2012, Texas students began taking the State of Texas Assessments of Academic Readiness (STAAR) exams. The Texas Education Agency (TEA), in collaboration with the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board (THECB) and Texas educators, developed the STAAR program in response to requirements set forth by the 80th and 81st Texas legislatures. STAAR is an assessment program designed to measure the extent to which students have learned and are able to apply the knowledge and skills defined in the state-mandated curriculum standards, the Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills (TEKS); and to focus on increasing postsecondary readiness of graduating high school students.

This spring, Houston ISD students took nearly 70,000 STAAR end-of-course (EOC) assessments in the following five subjects: Algebra I, Biology, English I, English II, and U.S. History. In general, students must pass the five STAAR EOC assessments in order to earn a high school diploma from a Texas public or charter school, as required in Texas Education Code (TEC) 39.025.

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- STAAR Accommodated (STAAR A) is the online assessment version of STAAR for students with disabilities that meet the STAAR A eligibility requirements. STAAR A provides embedded supports designed to help students with disabilities access the content being assessed. These embedded supports include visual aids, graphic organizers, and text-to-speech functionality.
- STAAR Alternate 2 (STAAR Alt. 2) STAAR Alt 2 is an assessment for students with significant cognitive disabilities receiving special education services.

The results shown in this report are for STAAR, STAAR L, Accommodated and Alternate 2 test versions.

Performance Results for the State, District and Campuses

Table 1 (p. 4) and Figure 1 (p. 5) display the percentages of students who met Satisfactory standards for Houston ISD and the State, for all STAAR EOC subjects, from 2012 to 2016. Table 1 shows results for first-time tested students, while Figure 1 shows all students tested. Table 2 (p. 4) presents a gap analysis by student group for first-time testers comparing the first year the test was administered to the 2016 results. Figure 2 (p. 5) displays the percentages of HISD students who met Satisfactory standards separately for first-time testers, retesters, and all students, for all STAAR EOC subjects, from 2012 to 2016. Figures 3–24 show district performance by test version, proficiency level, and student group for first-time testers and all testers. Campus participation and performance can be found in Tables A through E, followed by Campus Snapshots which display a variety of STAAR EOC results for individual HISD campuses. A summary of key findings is listed below.

Key Findings

- The proportion of first-time tested students who passed the 2016 STAAR EOC ranged from 62% in English I to 92% in U.S. History (Table 1, p. 4).
- The proportion of first-time tested students who passed the 2016 STAAR EOC **increased** in three of the five subjects (English I, English II, and U.S. History) and remained steady in Algebra and Biology when compared to spring 2015 results (Table 1).
- Table 2 (p. 4) shows performance gaps between White and African-American students and White and Hispanic students for each subject in 2016 and the year in which the exam was first administered. The gaps have decreased slightly and/or remained stable over time for Algebra I, Biology, English I and U.S. History.
- The proportion of students who met the 2016 Student standard on the STAAR EOC U.S. History exam was the highest for all three student testing groups (all students, first-time testers, and retesters) compared to the other four subjects. However, it should be noted that there were fewer students tested in U.S. History, which is typically a junior-level course. (Figure 2, p. 5)
- The percentages of students who met the Final Recommended and Advanced standard (Postsecondary Readiness) increased in all EOC subjects when compared to the 2015 results (Figures 3–4, p. 6). First-time testers saw between four and six percentage-point improvements in the proportion of students performing at the Final Recommended standard and between one and four percentage-point improvements at the Advanced standard across all EOC content areas.
- Figures 5 and 6 (p. 7–8) display the performance of first-time testers and all students by the four largest racial/ethnic groups. Among first-time testers, a smaller proportion of African-American students met the 2016 Student standard than that of Hispanic, White, and Asian students across all EOC exams. Between 2012 and 2016, the proportion of students who met the Final Recommended standard increased for almost every racial/ethnic group in every subject (except among Asian students in Algebra I and U.S. History where there is no change and a slight decline).
- English Language Learners (ELLs) who took STAAR EOC exams were significantly less likely to
 meet the 2016 Student standard compared to their more English-fluent peers in the same test version
 (Figures 7–8, p. 9). The largest performance gaps are witnessed in both English STAAR EOC exams.
- Approximately one-third of ELLs who took STAAR L EOC exams in Algebra, Biology, and U.S. History met the 2016 Student standard (**Figures 9–10**, p. 10)
- Figures 13 and 14 (p. 12) display the performance of first-time testers and all students by economic status. Students identified as non-economically-disadvantaged outperformed those identified as economically-disadvantaged by fewer than 10 points in Algebra, Biology, and U.S. History; gaps between these two groups in English EOC exams are more pronounced.
- Almost all students identified as Gifted and Talented (GT) met the 2016 Student standard in each of the five EOC exams (Figures 15–16, p. 13)—performance ranged from 97 percent in both English I and English II to 100 percent in Biology.
- Students with disabilities (SWD) who took STAAR EOC exams for the first time had varied success in meeting 2016 Student standards—ranging from 16 percent in English I to 60 percent in U.S. History (Figures 17–18, p. 14)
- A minority of first-time testers who took STAAR Accommodated met the 2016 Student standards—seven percent in English I to 29 percent in U.S. History (Figures 19–20, p. 15)
- The majority of students who took STAAR Alt 2 met 2016 Student standard—from 88 percent in Algebra to 93 percent in English II and U.S. History (**Figure 21**, **p. 15**)
- Students who were new to Texas were less likely to achieve the same level of proficiency on STAAR EOC exams as their counterparts (Figure 24, p. 17). The largest gaps were witnessed in English I (18 percent and 52 percent, respectively); smallest gaps were in U.S. History (84 percent and 90 percent, respectively).






First-Time Tested - All Grade Levels All Students





HISD STAAR EOC Performance by Subject: 2012-2016 (Spring Administration)


Percent Met Level II Satisfactory (Student), Final Recommended, and Advanced Standards

First-Time Tested - All Grade Levels All Students





All Students Tested (includes 1st time and retested students combined) - All Grade Levels All Students



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

English Language Learners (ELLs) and Non-English Language Learners (Non-ELLs)





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

English Language Learners First-Time Tested - All Grade Levels All Students





English Language Learners All Students Tested (includes 1st time and retested students combined) - All Grade Levels All Students



Percent Met or Exceeded ELL Progress Measures


English Language Learners First-Time Tested - All Grade Levels All Students



Economically Disadvantaged (Econ. Dis.) and Non-Economically Disadvantaged (Non-Econ. Dis.)









Students with Disabilities (SWDs) and Students without Disabilities (Non-SWDs)










Students with Disabilities - All Grade Levels All Students





First Time Tested - All Grade Levels All Students






