The Houston Independent School District (HISD) has received the results for the December 2017 administration of the State of Texas Assessments of Academic Readiness End-of-Course (STAAR EOC) exams. These exams were given to eligible students who did not meet the satisfactory level of performance in previous administrations (retesters), as well as students who completed a course and tested for the first time.

In Fall 2017, Houston ISD students took nearly 19,000 STAAR EOC assessments in the following five subjects: Algebra I, Biology, English I, English II, and U.S. History. In general, students must pass the five STAAR EOC assessments to earn a high school diploma from a Texas public or charter school, as required in Texas Education Code (TEC) 39.025.

STAAR Exam Versions

In 2017, there are two versions of the STAAR exams offered to students taking high school courses:

- **STAAR** is available to all students who do not qualify for the STAAR Alternate 2 assessment.
 - The STAAR test now includes accessibility features and designated supports for students. Subsequently, the STAAR L (Linguistically Accommodated) and A (Accommodated) test versions are no longer administered.
- STAAR Alternate 2 (STAAR Alt. 2) is an assessment for students with significant cognitive disabilities receiving special education services.

To provide more accurate year-to-year comparisons, previous STAAR administration results have been updated to include STAAR L and A test versions.

STAAR Administrations

All five STAAR EOC assessments required for graduation—Algebra I, Biology, English I, English II, and U.S. History—are administered at the end of the first semester (fall), at the end of the second semester (spring), and in the summer, giving students three testing opportunities each year.

The STAAR EOC assessments calendar is shown below and displays the various districtwide tests administered during the fall of 2017. All STAAR tests have a four-hour time limit; however, students who meet eligibility criteria may have accommodations for extra time or an extra day.

The next testing window is May 7 – 11, 2018 for Algebra I, Biology, and U.S. History. English I and II will be tested on April 10 and 12, 2018 respectively.

STAAR Standards

An amendment to TAC 19 §101.3041 halted the planned standard phase-in process and established the 2016 progression, final recommended, and advanced standards as the final set of performance standards for any student taking a STAAR End-of-Course exam for the first time during or after the December 2015 administration. Students who took their first End-of-Course exam prior to the December 2015 administration will continue to be held to the phase-in 1 standard. In addition, the proficiency level descriptors were updated as shown below:

Performance at or above the Approaches Grade Level standard satisfies the graduation requirement for each End-of-Course exam.

Key findings include:

- Of the 19,045 STAAR EOC tests administered in December 2017, 15% (2,816) were taken by ninth-grade students, 35% (6,647 tests) were taken by tenth-grade students, 32% (6,074 tests) were taken by eleventh-grade students, and 18% (3,504 tests) were taken by twelfth-grade students.
- Of the 2,816 STAAR EOC tests taken by ninth-grade students, 1,092 (39%) were taken in English I and 986 (35%) were taken in Algebra I.
- The percent of All Students (includes both first-time and retested students) performing at or above the Approaches Grade Level standard ranged from 15% (English I and English II) to 37% (U.S. History).
- Most of the students who tested in December were English I or English II "re-testers."
- When compared to last year's results, the percentage of students performing at or above the Approaches Grade Level standard **decreased** in Algebra I (2 percentage points), U.S.

History (2 percentage points), Biology (5 percentage points), English I (5 percentage points), and English II (8 percentage points).

Administrative Responses to the 2017 STAAR EOC results:

With only approximately 11 weeks between the first day of school and testing dates, campuses worked quickly to prepare students for the December testing windows. The Secondary Curriculum and Development team continues to revise and develop curriculum resources and provides teacher coaching on implementation of high-quality instruction. These STAAR results show the increased need for aligned systems to meet the needs of re-testers. More competency-based curriculum resources are being developed specifically for teachers of retesters. In addition to prioritizing the development of these resources, the department will continue to work alongside School Support Officers to ensure that best practices for interventions are in place at all secondary schools. Additionally, Secondary Curriculum and Development leaders will help assess campus systems for re-testers to ensure that all individual student needs are met, and that achievement gaps are closed through differentiated instruction.


